

Journal of a Whaling voyage on board Barque
 Geo Henrietta January 1854

Fri 16 A strong breeze from N to NE
 steering SW by S and
 some rain in squalls one
 sail in sight

Sat 17 A strong breeze from Eastward Barque Warren
 steering SW by S some rain Ship Emerald
 at 5 AM we saw the Island of Ship Josephine
 New Zealand at 10 came to anchor Barque Monthe
 in mangana & the capt his Ship Finch Swift
 Wife & boy went on shore
 Employed getting off Wood
 the Barque Warren came in &
 landed some passengers and
 Went out again the ship
 Emerald of Sag Harbor came in
 and anchored

Sun 18 A fresh breeze from the East
 Hand Employed getting off
 Wood at 11 AM the capt came
 on board & got underway & just
 to sea the capt left his Wife and
 boy on shore

Mon 19 A light breeze from Northward
 & Eastward steering NW some
 Rain land in sight

Tues 20 A light breeze & Rainy Weather
 those things in sight
 Latter part fresh breeze & clear
 Weather caught a porpoise &
 gained with the ship Hiloria
 of N.B capt Harveywell



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 Barque Geo Henrietta January 1854 ^{crossed the Sat Long}
 Thurs 8 A fresh breeze from SE by S in
 various tacks & sails in sight
 saw grampuses

Fri 9 A strong breeze from E on different
 tacks spoke ship monte gumarf
 capt & foremast
 new London Macaulay Island
 & Curtis Hook in sight

Sat 10 E steering SW by W
 fore part strong breeze from
 Middle & latter parts light
 breeze from SE employed fit
 ting new bowsprit stands

Sun 11 A fine breeze from the southward
 & Eastward & pleasant Weather
 at sundown shortened sail at
 daylight made sail

Mon 12 A light breeze from SE steering
 SW by W shortened sail at
 sundown made sail at daylight
 & sails in sight

Tues 13 A light breeze from E to NE
 steering to the Northward and
 Westward gained with the fire
 swift capt Carl P. Barque Warren
 capt Wilcox

Thursday Jan the 15th
 fore part strong breeze from N
 steering SW by S Rainy Weather
 Middle & latter parts light
 breeze from NW by W NW
 no sail in sight
