

## Ship Mary & Susan towards the Japan Sea

**Saturday** These 24 hours commenced with strong trades and squally 2 arrivals the Captain gave to town to obtain pass 1849. parts and open for recruiting Middle hours strong trades. Variation 6. E. equally latter hours the same and watch on liberty 2 days Laying at Anchor

**Sunday** These 24 hours commenced with strong trades and heavy squalls of rain at 8 P.M. the Master and Anchor and paid out 30 fathoms of 6 pound Middle hours the Variation 6. E. ng trades and squally latter hours the same hours of rain Laying at Anchor

**Monday** These 24 hours commenced with strong trades and equally employed repairing the typhoon at 7 P.M. the water came along side the Bay for 2 hours Middle hours more moderate Variation 6. E. latter hours pleasant and watch on liberty 2 days the Bay for 2 hours Laying at Anchor

**Tuesday** These 24 hours commenced with moderate pleasant weather the trades light employed beating off Potatoes and other small fish and heard Middle hours strong trades and mostly clear Variation 6. E. latter hours light air and pleasant the Bay Mary came on duty Laying at Anchor

**Wednesday** These 24 hours commenced with light trades and fine pleasant weather employed on various jobs of ship duty Middle hours light trades and mostly clear latter hours strong trades employed beating off Potatoes and cutting wood several arrivals Laying at Anchor

**Thursday** These 24 hours commenced with strong trades and passing clouds employed cutting wood and beating it off and heard the ship Middle hours strong trades and squally Variation 6. E. latter hours strong trades and heavy old sea leaving in Laying at Anchor

**Friday** These 24 hours commenced with strong trades and passing clouds took on board 500 lbs of sweet Potatoes and 2 head bars of wood Middle hours strong trades and squally latter hours equally employed beating off Potatoes Laying at Anchor

**Saturday** These 24 hours commenced with strong trades and squally employed on small jobs of ship duty took on board some Potatoes and yams Middle hours strong trades and passing clouds latter hours the same 3 arrivals Laying at Anchor

**Sunday** These 24 hours commenced with strong trades and passing clouds several arrivals Middle hours strong trades and passing clouds latter hours pleasant employed on shore digging yams and beating them off to the ship Laying at Anchor

**Monday** These 24 hours commenced with strong trades and passing clouds employed on shore digging yams and beating them off shore the wood below and cleared up decks Middle hours strong trades and pleasant latter hours the same passing clouds Laying at Anchor

**Tuesday** These 24 hours commenced with strong trades passing clouds and pleasant took on board sweet Potatoes and heard Middle hours light winds and passing clouds at 9 P.M. got underway with the Pilot and stood out anchorage the Pilot and mid shore for Monday latter hours strong trades and pleasant Laying at Anchor

**Wednesday** These 24 hours commenced with fresh trades and passing clouds running down for Monday at 3 P.M. came to Anchor in 16 fathoms of water paid the sails 5 ships after water Middle hours light winds and passing clouds latter hours the trades light and smooth Laying at Anchor

**Thursday** These 24 hours commenced with light trades and passing clouds at 3 P.M. felt the shock of an earthquake at 6 P.M. a second shock at 7 the third and shatter the end of the beam and shore besides the water doing some damage on shore stood 2 boats and set several water casks adrift Middle hours light winds latter hours strong trades at 9 P.M. found the ship adrift here in found the Anchor gone the Swivel head had drawn through made sail and stood back for the Anchorage

**Friday** These 24 hours commenced with strong trades and passing clouds at 2 P.M. came to Anchor in 16 fathoms of water paid the sails and hoisted another Anchor on the bow and sent the chain Middle hours strong trades and passing clouds latter hours the same employed repairing the main topmast and main topgallant sail and sent them again Laying at Anchor

**Saturday** These 24 hours commenced with strong trades and passing clouds set 2 new boats on the wharves took on board ones to repair stored the Master and Anchor and cleared the decks Middle hours light winds and squalls of rain at daylight got underway and stood out for Apia Lat 13.19 North Long 144.11 East

**Sunday** These 24 hours commenced with strong trades at 1 P.M. heard aback off the Master and landed with the boat at 3 came on board and stood up for the tower in Pursuit of yams, clear and pleasant Middle hours strong trades and passing clouds at 10 last off and shore latter hours laying aback off the tower the Shipper on shore after yams Laying off and on the bow
