Variation 10. E. These 24 hours commences with strong winds from N.E. staying S.E. and cloudy at 3 P.M. squally wind at 4 P.M. made all sail set the topmast staysails. Middle hours strong winds and thick cloudy at 9 P.M. ten hours the wind from North steady rain & squally.

Sunday
Dec 13
Variation 10. E. These 24 hours commences with strong gales from N.E. thick rain during the day at 3 P.M. the wind N.W. the rain abating and clearing off at 9 A.M. it was in heavy squalls. Middle hours strong gales landed all by 1 P.M. sails and mainmast. Mizen topsails & 1st & 2nd reef the fore & main topsails. Latter hours heavy rain in squalls and rough during East & double reefed close in N.W. at 10.15 South Long 149.46 West

Monday
Dec 14
Variation 9. E. These 24 hours commences with strong gales blowing in squalls and rough wind. Mizen & 1st & 2nd reefed. at 9 A.M. and wash off several pieces of Suberula bottom the hatch made all secured. Middle hours strong gales and heavy squalls and rough. At 2 P.M. the foreward quarter hatch. Latter hours more moderate made single reef topsails and 1st & 2nd reefed.

Tuesday
Dec 15
Variation 8. E. These 24 hours commences with strong gales from N.W. having clouds bound by S at 1 P.M. made the mainmast at 3 main topgallant sail at 5 the fore and main ships. Under the fore. Middle hours strong gales and passing clouds shortly out of the main topsails at 3 P.M. squally. Latter hours strong gales and rough bound by S.

Variation 8. E. These 24 hours commences with strong gales from N.W. rough and passing clouds during the day S and main topgallant sails at 8 squally landed. Middle hours strong gales and the main again. Latter hours strong & squally.

Variation 8. E. These 24 hours commences with strong gales from N.W. westward rough and squally during the day S and main topgallant sails. Middle hours fresh winds and light rain. Latter hours wind N.W. attach clouds make all sail set by S.

Dec 18
Variation 8. E. These 24 hours commences with strong winds from N.W. and passing clouds bound by S. foreward main topgallant sails set. Middle hours fresh winds and squally. Light rain. Latter hours pleasant wind N.W. bound by S.

Dec 19
Variation 8. E. These 24 hours commences with fresh winds from N.W. and passing clouds during the day S and main topgallant sails. Middle hours fresh winds and squally. Latter hours pleasant wind N.W. bound by S.

Dec 20
Variation 9. E. These 24 hours commences with fresh winds from N.W. and passing clouds during the day S and main topgallant sails. Middle hours light winds and thick cloudy the wind hauling. Easterly in the mizen sails and landed by the wind. Latter hours strong gales and rain landed light sails at 11. At 1 P.M. it came in heavy squalls double reefed the topsails and the fore sailing. Dec 21
Variation 9. E. These 24 hours commences with fresh winds from N.E. heading by the wind S by S at 2 P.M. the wind N.W. thick fog at 4 P.M. made all sail set the topmast staysails. Middle hours the wind N.W. and thick fog bound by S. Latter hours fresh winds from N.W. and thick fog.

Tuesday
Dec 22
Variation 9. E. These 24 hours commences with strong winds from N.W. and thick fog bound by S. all sails set wind hauling. South by fog cleared off. Middle hours light air and hauling. Easterly. Latter hours the wind N.W. thick fog to the fore.

Wednesday
Dec 23
Variation 10. E. These 24 hours commences with fresh winds from N.W. heading by S at 3 P.M. rain landed topgallant sails & double reefed the topsails. Flowing strong at 6 P.M. much rain night. At 9 P.M. clouded up the topsails blowing heavy and squally. Under North. Middle hours strong gales wind. N.W. Latter hours wind N.W. and mostly clear all sails set. Pleasant.

Dec 24
Variation 10. E. These 24 hours commences with strong gales from N.W. N.W. passing clouds during the day S and main topgallant sails. Middle hours strong gales from N.W. during East & rain. Under and Lamb came on duty by Williams & duty.

Variation 10. E. These 24 hours commences with strong gales from N.W. N.W. turning East thick cloudy and squally of fog. Middle hours strong gales from N.W. to N.W. Latter hours the wind strong. Parted fore topgallant staysails bound & shaly.

Variation 12. E. These 24 hours commences with strong gales from N.W. turning E. repaired the fore topmast staysails and had a new fore topmast staysails set. It having clouds. Middle hours strong gales from N.W. thick cloudy bound by S. Latter hours strong gales thick cloudy and light squally rain.

Dec 27
Variation 12. E. These 24 hours commences with strong gales from N.W. turning E. thick cloudy and light rain all sail set. Middle hours light rain. Middle North. Latter hours the wind hauled to N.W. blowing strong. Sails reefed the topsails bound by S.

Dec 28
Variation 16. E. These 24 hours commences with strong gales from N.W. and squally turning East under and reefed topsails rough. Middle hours strong gales bound the mizen topsails. Latter hours more moderate made all sail the wind N.W. turning East.

Tuesday
Dec 29
Variation 18. E. These 24 hours commences with strong winds from N.W. turning East. At 6 P.M. it came on thick cloudy. Middle hours the wind N.W. Latter hours strong gales landed light sails double reefed.

Dec 30
Variation 22. E. These 24 hours commences with strong gales from N.W. and thick rain heading East. At 2 P.M. made mainmast and fore. Middle hours strong gales from the westward single reefed topsails and Latter hours strong gales all sail set and mostly clear.
