January 26th
1850.
Variation 3 E. These 24 hours commences pleasant the wind North heading E & S all sail set out by the wind repaired the fore top gallant sail and set it wind light & some Middle hours light winds & variable tail to the N & W latter hours strong gale and passing clouds Lat 21.25 South Long 34.48 West

Sunday
January 27th
1850.
Variation 3 E. These 24 hours commences with strong gale from the Northward heading E & S by the wind employed on the fore sail & both the foresails at 7.30 P M and after that too 6 placed before John W & Dingle and Jod Portogues John got badly stab in several places by the said Portogues and the Portogues badly wounded by the said John & Dingle watching with John through the night Middle hours strong gale and squally at 6 A M we set the top sails and to the N & W latter hours moderate wind to the East and made whole top sails the North & variable Lat 21.05 South Long 34.30 West

Monday
January 28th
Variation 3 E. These 24 hours commences with variable winds from the Northward heading E & S light squalls of rain and cold E. & S heading S & W Middle hours strong gale latter hours the wind variable and squally wind at the N & W Lat 21.04 South Long 33.25 West

Tuesday
January 29th
Variation 3 E. These 24 hours commences with strong gale from the Northward and variable heading N & W at 1 P M we E. regard to moderate made fore and main top gallant sails Middle hours strong winds and clear at daylight and cold and 3 sails latter pleasant repaired main top sail Lat 19.55 South Long 35.03 West

Wednesday
January 30th
Variation 4 E. These 24 hours commences with strong gale from the N & S variable heading N & W all sail set out by the wind at 4 P M the Middle hours strong gale & cloudy heading N & W by the winds latter hours strong gale from the Northward heading to the N & S. Lat 18.55 South Long 36.44 West

Thursday
January 31st
Variation 4 E. These 24 hours commences with strong gale from the Northward & variable heading N & E by the winds whole top sail out. Middle hours strong gale & squalling clouds made the main top gallant sail. Lat 19.00 South Long 36.40 West

Friday
February 1st
Variation 2 E. These 24 hours commences with pleasant & great the wind & variable heading N & E by the wind Parted the main top gallant. Day Jettied a new gun & put it over the ship at 10 A M & P M made the fore & main top gallant sail. Middle hours strong winds from N & E. latter hours strong winds & pleasant weather & parted the fore top gallant & fore top sail. Lat 18.25 South Long 36.59 West

Saturday
Feb 2nd
Variation 2 E. These 24 hours commences with fresh breeze from the N & E. Steering N & W by the winds: repaired the fore top gallant & fore top sail & put them over the masthead set up the rigging & parted the fore top gallant & fore top sail. Middle hours light winds & squalling clouds. At 1 P M it came in equal by 1 P M John W & Dingle died from the inflammation

of the fever caused by wounds from a knife. Latter hours light winds & variable heading N & W by the winds Lat 17.15 South Long 35.25 West

Feb 3rd
Variation 2 E. These 24 hours commences with light winds from N & E. heading N & W by the winds. At 1 P M all hands as perilled & killed our deceased man John W & Dingle. Middle hours strong winds from N & E. Latter hours fresh breeze from N & E. heading N & W. Lat 15.45 South Long 36.06 West

Monday
Feb 4th
Variation 4 E. These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather wind E & S heading N & W all requisite sail set by the wind. Lat 14.30 South Long 36.06 West

Tuesday
Feb 5th
Variation 5 W. These 24 hours commences with strong gale from the Northward & variable heading N & W by the winds. Latter hours strong gale from N & E. heading N & W. Lat 13.59 South Long 35.58 West

Wednesday
Feb 6th
Variation 5 W. These 24 hours commences with strong gale from the Northward & variable heading N & W by the winds. Latter hours strong gale from N & E. heading N & W. Lat 12.11 South Long 35.58 West

Thursday
Feb 7th
Variation 6 W. These 24 hours commences with strong gale from the Northward & variable heading N & W by the winds. Latter hours strong gale from N & E. heading N & W. Lat 10.35 South Long 35.27 West

Friday
Feb 8th
Variation 6 W. These 24 hours commences with strong gale from the Northward & variable heading N & W by the winds. Latter hours strong gale from N & E. heading N & W. Lat 9.16 South Long 35.58 West
