Feb 13th
1850.
Variation 3 W. These 24 hours commence with light trades from E. & fine pleasant weather Steering N. with all sail out. Employed in various jobs of Ship's duty. Middle hours fresh breeze & falling clouds. Latter hours it came in equally in falling sails & strong wind N.E. Steering N.W. Lat 4.48 North Long 37.30 West.

Thursday
Feb 14th
Variation 4 W. These 24 hours commence with fresh breeze from N.E. & thick cloudy weather Steering N.W. at 2 P.M. made a main royal & flying jib. Middle hours light breeze & falling clouds. Latter hours fresh breeze from the Eastward & equally with heavy rain. Lat 5.40 North Long 38.25 West.

Friday
Feb 15th
Variation 4 W. These 24 hours commence with light breeze from N.E. & falling clouds Steering N.W. Made for & main royal & a topmast stay sail. Middle hours equally in Steering N.W. & falling clouds. Latter hours fresh breeze from N.E. & fine pleasant weather. This morning employed in setting sails. Lat 7.02 North Long 40.17 West.

Saturday
Feb 16th
Variation 3 W. These 24 hours commence with fresh breeze from N.E. & fine pleasant weather Steering N.W. Employed in racking down the rigging. Middle hours the wind & weather the same. Latter hours fresh breeze from N.E. & falling clouds. Lat 8.05 North Long 41.34 West.

Sunday
Feb 17th
Variation 2 W. These 24 hours commence with fresh breeze from N.W. & fine pleasant weather Steering N.W. By the wind with all sail out. Employed in racking down the rigging. Middle hours fresh breeze from N.E. Steering N.W. Latter hours the same. Lat 9.19 North Long 43.38 West.

Feb 18th
Variation 3 W. These 24 hours commence with fresh breeze from N.E. & fine pleasant weather Steering N.W. Middle hours fresh breeze from N.E. & falling clouds. Lat the topmast stay sail. Latter hours fresh breeze & fine pleasant weather. Lat 10.41 North Long 45.40 West.

Variation 4 W. These 24 hours commence with fresh breeze from N.E. & fine pleasant weather Steering N.W. Employed in Steering the standing rigging. Middle hours fresh breeze from E. & variable. Lat 11.00 North Long 47.57 West.

Variation 4 W. These 24 hours commence with strong trades & falling clouds Steering N.W. with all sail out. Employed in standing rigging. Middle hours light breeze & fine pleasant weather. Latter hours light breeze & pleasant. Finishing the standing rigging. Lat 13.36 North Long 49.48 West.

Feb 21th
Variation 4 W. These 24 hours commence with light breeze from E.N.E. & fine pleasant weather Steering N.W. with all sail out. Employed in painting in various places. Middle hours strong trades & equal by weather. Latter hours strong breeze & heavy with all sail out. Lat 15.02 North Long 51.57 West.

Friday
Feb 22th
Variation 3 W. These 24 hours commence with strong trades from E.N.E. & pleasant weather Steering N.W. Employed on various jobs of Ship's duty. Middle hours strong trades & falling clouds. Latter hours the main topmast stay sail. Latter hours fresh breeze from N.W. Lat 16.46 North Long 54.30 West.

Feb 23th

Variation 3 W. These 24 hours commence with fresh breeze & fine pleasant weather Steering N.W. Employed in painting bulwark & middle house fresh breeze from E. & falling clouds. Latter hours light breeze from N.W. Lat 17.17 North Long 56.38 West.

Sunday
Feb 24th
1850.
Variation 3 W. These 24 hours commence with light breeze from E. & fine pleasant weather Steering N.W. with all sail out. Employed in painting the bulwark & windlass. Middle hours strong breeze & variable & equally. Latter hours light breeze & pleasant. Lat 19.39 North Long 58.30 West.

Monday
Feb 25th
Variation 2 W. These 24 hours commence with light breeze from E.N.E. & fine pleasant weather Steering N.W. with all sail out. Middle hours light breeze from E. & pleasant weather. Latter hours light breeze from E. Lat 21.58 North Long 60.20 West.

Tuesday
Feb 26th
Variation 2 W. These 24 hours commence with light breeze from E. & fine pleasant weather Steering N.W. with all sail out. Employed in painting the lower masts, &c. Middle hours light breeze & fine pleasant weather. Latter hours very light breeze & calm. Lat 22.04 North Long 61.18 West.

Wednesday
Feb 27th
Variation 2 W. These 24 hours commence with very light breeze from the Eastward & variable Steering N.W. with all sail out. Employed in various jobs of Ship's duty & in scrubbing the Ship's sides. Middle hours calm with shading sails & royal. Latter hours a light breeze springs up from N.W. Steering N.W. spoke the hermaphrodite by the name of Boston bound to Curacao 12 days out. She is bound to Liverpool. Lat 23.23 North Long 61.32 West.

Thursday
Feb 28th
Variation 2 W. These 24 hours commence with light breeze from the Westward & variable with pleasant weather Steering N.W. by the wind. Employed on various jobs of Ship's duty. Middle hours fresh breeze from the Westward & pleasant weather Steering N.W. by the wind. Latter hours strong breeze & at 7 P.M. had a heavy squall of rain & rain took in the light sails it then cleared off & we set them again. Lat 25.31 North Long 61.33 West.

Friday
March 1st
Variation 1 W. These 24 hours commence with strong breeze from the N.W. Steering N.W. by the wind. Had a big cloud Steering along with the 61.33. P.M. packed to the N.W. & Middle hours strong breeze & falling clouds. Latter hours fresh breeze from N.E. Steering N.W. Lat 26.28 North Long 63.52 West.

Saturday
March 2nd
Variation 1 W. These 24 hours commence with fresh breeze from E.N.E. & fine pleasant weather Steering N.W. with all sail out. Employed on various jobs of Ship's duty. Middle hours light breeze & variable. Latter hours light breeze & pleasant. Finishing the standing rigging. Lat 28.07 North Long 63.44 West.

Sunday
March 3rd
Variation 2 W. These 24 hours commence with light breeze from the Westward & pleasant weather Steering N.W. by the wind. Employed on various jobs of Ship's duty. Middle hours strong breeze & variable. Latter hours light breeze & at 7.30 tacked to the N.W. Lat 29.39 North Long 63.44 West.

Monday
March 4th
Variation 3 W. These 24 hours commence with light breeze from the Northward & pleasant weather. Middle hours light breeze from the Westward. Latter hours the same Steering N.W. by the wind. Lat 26.45 North Long 64.08 West.

Tuesday
March 5th
Variation 3 W. These 24 hours commence with fresh breeze from the Westward & pleasant weather Steering N.W. by the wind. At 3 P.M. spoke the hermaphrodite by the name of Santa Rosa 5 days out. Middle hours strong breeze & equally with the light breeze.
