Remarks Wednesday Sept 19th 1877
Begins with moderate breezes from N.W. and a heavy swell. Latter part light air and calm. Two merchant-men in sight.

Lat 33-15 Long 32-55

Remarks Thursday Sept 20th
Begins with light air from the N.W. and a heavy Northwesterly swell. Latter part moderate breezes from S.W. Coopersed, filled and marked the oil ready for shipping home.

Lat 33-04 Long 33-05

Remarks Friday Sept 21st
Begins with moderate breezes from the S.W. Stowed the oil stow between decks. A heavy swell from the N.W. Latter part moderate breeze. passed the ship Scotchman Chief.

Lat 33-11 Long 33-11

Remarks Saturday Sept 22nd
Begins with moderate breezes from the S. and a very heavy N.W. swell. There must be heavy winds somewhere to the N. of us, and that far off either. Latter part light air.

Lat 33-09 Long 33-10

Remarks Sunday Sept 23rd
Begins with light air and calm. Saw two sails. A heavy swell from the Westward. Latter part moderate breezes from N.E. heading by to the N. a sail in sight.

Monday Lat 33-21 Long 33-04

Remarks Sunday Sept 24th
Begins with fresh breezes from E.N.E. Latter part fresh breezes from S.E. Course E.N.E. Saw two merchantmen. O dear this is hard for me. I long for home.

Lat 34-30 Long 32-27

Bark Mary & Susan. Cruising on the Western Brounce.

Remarks Tuesday Sept 25th 1877
Begins with strong winds from the South. Course E.N.E. winds increasing. At sundown took in sail except the two double reefed top sails. Latter part a Gale from S. at 7 P.M. took in the fore top sail and luffed too under a double reefed top sail.

Remarks Wednesday Sept 26th
Begins with a Gale from the S. and a back sea. Latter part moderated. The wind hauled round to the N. at 5 P.M. were ship to the E.N.E. under double reef.

Lat 36-36 Long 30-32

Remarks Thursday Sept 27th
Begins with strong winds from the N. heading by to the E.N.E. Spoke the bark Kathleen 26 months out - 700 Sprm. Latter part strong winds from N. a whaling bark in sight.

Lat 37-03 Long 29-50

Remarks Friday Sept 28th
Begins with strong winds from N. at 2 P.M. spoke the bark Matilda Seers of Dartmouth 27 days out. Then. Latter part light breezes and a heavy swell. Bark Matilda in company.

Lat 37-12 Long 29-34

Remarks Saturday Sept 29th
Begins with light breezes from N.E. Spoke the bark again. Took 24 letters to mail at Cayal for them. Latter part calm. the bark Matilda Seers in sight. Capt. Bennett gave me a Pig.
