

Bark Mary & Susan. Toward Cape Horn.

Remarks Friday Oct 12th 1877

Begins with light winds from Eastward. Course S by E. Middle part calm. Latter part light breezes from westward heading S. fitted the Mainsail.

Lat 30-58 Long 27-40

Remarks Saturday Oct 13th

Begins with light breezes from S by W. Reading S by E. I got a Quarter of Beef at Wray's. Spr. has had a good time eating it. He begins to look as he did when we sailed. fat. and sleek. He will not eat salt meat. When we don't have fresh meat or fish, he eats white bread and sugar cake. No molasses cake for him. Middle and latter parts fresh breezes from S.W. heading by to the Southward. a squall chasing us all the forenoon.

Lat 28-53 Long 26-17

Remarks Sunday Oct 14th.

Begins with fresh breezes from W & W. heading by to the Southward. Middle and latter part light airs and calms. five merchantmen in sight.

Lat 27-23 Long 25-49

Remarks Monday Oct 15th.

Begins with moderate breezes from N.E. to E.S.E. I think that it will finally turn to N.E. trades. Latter part moderate breezes from S.E. heading by to the Southward.

Lat 25-35 Long 25-41

Remarks Tuesday Oct 16th

Begins with moderate breezes from E.S.E. Course S by W. Saw Barkentine. Latter part pleasant trades. by well to the East about E by S.

Lat 22-38 Long 25-29

Remarks Wednesday Oct 17th

Begins with fresh trades from E by S. Course S by W. Saw two sails. Latter part fresh trades from E.N.E. Saw one sail steering S by S.

Lat 19-37 Long 25-32

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Remarks Thursday Oct 18th 1877

Begins with fresh trades from E.S.E. Course S by W. at 3 P.M. St. Antoine bearing S 1/2 E Dist 120 miles. at 5 1/2 A.M. raised St. Antoine. bearing E by S Dist 15 miles. at 9 A.M. he calmed under its lee. at 10 1/2 took the trades over St. Angelo down by the East End. took in all the light sail and double reefed the top sails. at 10 Shaped the course for Dravo.

Lat 16-34 Long 25-09

Remarks Friday Oct 19th

Begins with fresh trades steering for Dravo. South. at 3 P.M. by Dist by altitudes 80 miles. at 6 P.M. supposed distance 60 miles. Latter part moderate trades and very squally. steering for Dravo as I supposed. But by some unknown cause. either a strong westerly current, or a mistake in yesterday's Long. we passed to the Westward of it. so that we could not see it. It was so thick, that we could not see it over 10 miles. A I do not think we could see it that. so I gave up going there. and lose the chance of sending my letters.

Lat 14-37 Long 25-05

Remarks Saturday Oct 20th

Begins with light airs and calms. and very warm. Latter part calm. caught two blackfish.

Lat 14-10 Long 25-00

Remarks Sunday Oct 21

Begins with moderate trades from E.S.E. Course S by W. Latter part pleasant trades. Saw two sails.

Lat 11-39 Long 24-52

Remarks Monday Oct 22

Begins with pleasant trades. Course S by W. Latter part squally. at 10 A.M. the wind shifted to the S.S. and continued bearing from S by E to S. three sails in sight. Bailed out the blackfish made 4 bbls. no obs
