Remarks Saturday Nov 17th 1877
Begin with light breezes from S & W and
a heavy S W swell. Latter part Calm, repaired
the main top sail. Lat 26-35 Long 38-16

Remarks Sunday Nov 18th
Begin with Calm. at 3 P.M. took a light breeze
from S.E. Course S.W. by S. One sail in sight.
Latter part light breezes and fine. Lat 27-27 Long 39-10

Remarks Monday Nov 19th
Begin with moderate breezes from S.E. Course
S.W. by S. Saw blimp & backs. Latter part fresh
breezes from E. Set up the rigging at the main
Lat 29-39 Long 40-39

Remarks Tuesday Nov 20th
Begin with fresh breezes from E. Course
S.W. Driz in light steering S.W. by W.
Latter part fresh breezes from N.E.
Hauling down the main rigging Lat 31-36 Long 42-58

Remarks Wednesday Nov 21st
Begin with fresh breezes from N.E. Course
S.W. Latter part strong winds and hazy.
Lat 33-50 Long 45-15

Remarks Thursday Nov 22nd
Begin with strong winds from
N.E. and thick weather. at 6 P.M. took
the main top gall sail, and double reefed the
main top sail. Fore top sail close reefed.
at 7 began to rain. Middle and latter part
blowing a gale from the N.E. and raining. at 12 M.
began to moderate with the appearance of
a change. Barometer 29 3/10. the lowest
we have had it since we left home.
So Ends.

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Remarks Friday Nov 23rd 1877
Begin with a moderating gale from N.E.
Moderating very fast. at 1 1/2 P.M. the wind
hauling to the South. Took in the fore sail, and
close reefed the main top sail, and have too
head to the westward. at 5 1/2 took in the
fore top sail. Ship now under close
reefed main top sail and stay sails.
Barometer 29 3/10. at 7 P.M. 29 1/10. and
rising. Middle part moderating. at 10 1/2 P.M. found
that we had carried away the tick band on the main
top sail yard. repaired it by riveting a piece of
an old band on it. Lat 36-17 Long 48-19
at noon Barometer 30-

Remarks Saturday Nov 24th
Begin with moderate breezes from S.W.
Heaving by to the S.W. at 4 P.M. got the
band aloft and made all sail.
Barometer 30 1/10 Latter part moderate breezes
from N.E. Course S.W. by S. Employed making
a fore stay sail. Saw a great number of
fin backs. Lat 37-37 Long 50-16

Remarks Sunday Nov 25th
Begin with moderate breezes from the
N.E. Course S.W. by S. at 6 P.M. we
began to thicken up and breeze increase.
again canting a little to the Eastward.
Barometer 30-1/10 Latter part pleasant
breezes from W.N.W. Barometer 30°

Remarks Monday Nov 26th
Begin with pleasant breezes from
the Westward. Hauling to the
Southward. Barometer slowly falling.
at 7 P.M. Bar 29 8/10. Wind S.W. and
a thick fog. Middle part wind W. at 3 A.M.
wind hauled to W.S.W. and began to blow
on. Double reefed. at 5 close reefed. Latter part a
gale under close reefed & sail. Lat 41-03 Long 52-28
