Begin with moderate breeze from S.W. to W. S.
W. saw 8 Min 8 Ducks. Bar 30 1/4 Latter part fresh
breeze from W to W. N.W. saw the bark John &
Minthrap whaling. saw him take whale along side.
Bar 29 9/10. Lat 38-31 Long 75-39.

Remarks Wednesday Jan 16th.
Begin with fresh breeze from W. with a
heavy S to S.W. Bar 29 9/10. Latter moderate
fresh S E and foggy. Lat 37-12 Long 76-08

Remarks Thursday Jan 17th.
Begin with calm and light air from
Eastward. and thick. Bar 29 9/10.
Latter part light air and calm. saw Grampus.
Lat 37-05 Long 76-05

Remarks Friday Jan 18th.
Begin with light wind calm. at 6 P.M.
wind hauled to the N.N.W. Bar 29 9/10.
Latter part all kinds of winds and weather
from a gale from the N to a calm and light air from
S.W. Bar 29 9/10 Lat 37-03 Long 76-34.

Remarks Saturday Jan 19th.
Begin with fresh breeze from W. Latter
part fresh breeze from S. saw Sulphur Bottoms.
Bar 30 Lat 37-46 Long 76-10

Remarks Sunday Jan 20th.
Begin with fresh breeze from S. saw a whaling
bark. Latter part strong winds from
the S.E. under double reef. Bar 30 1/10

Begin with strong winds from S.E.
saw Sulphur Bottoms. Bar 30 1/10.
Latter part pleasant breeze from S.E. all sail set.
Lat 37-40 Long 75-32

Remarks Tuesday Jan 22nd.
Begin with fresh breeze from S.E. at
2 P.M. Land in just south of Calderia 50 miles
dist. Bar 30 1/10. Latter part fresh breeze from
the S. Course N. Lat 37-20 Long 75-18

Remarks Wednesday Jan 23rd.
Begin with strong winds from S. Course
N. at 7 P.M. luffed too and close reef. Bar
30. Latter part moderate gale. Steering N.N.E. under short
sail. Lat 37-59 Long 74-40

Remarks Thursday Jan 24th.
Begin with a fresh gale from S.E. Steering
N.N.E. at 7 P.M. luffed too under two close reefs. Bar
30. Latter part a gale. under close reef and stay sails
Lat 37-10 Long 74-34.

Remarks Friday Jan 25th.
Begin with a gale from S.E. head to the S.W.
under close reef and stay sails Bar 29 9/10.
Latter part a gale. Lat 37-10 Long 76-01.

Remarks Saturday Jan 26th.
Begin with a gale from S.E. under close
reef. at 6 P.M. took in Bare Top sail. Bar 29 9/10.
Latter part a gale. the Bark have to under close
reef main Top sail. Lat 36-52 Long 76-03

Remarks Sunday Jan 27th.
Begin with a gale from the S. under
close reef main Top sail and stay sails.
Bar 29 9/10 Latter part more moderate. set
close reefs and Bare sail.
Bar 29 9/10 Lat 36-14 Long 75-12
