Begin with strong winds from S by E.
Latter part fresh Breezes. Employed Caspining to stow
down. Lat 37-03. Long 76-17.

Remarks Sunday March 10th.

Begin with fresh Breezes from the S. Employed
stowing oil. Stowed 57 bbls 14 1/2. Sails. Latter part
pleasant Breezes from S by W. Saw four whales.
The Lucretia drailing. Lat 37-05 Long 76-14

Remarks Monday March 11th.

Begin with pleasant Breezes from W.
Latter part Moderate Breezes from S by W.
Lat 37-21 Long 76-16

Remarks Tuesday March 12th.

Begin with Moderate Breezes from S by W.
Latter part fresh Breezes from the W. Saw Sulphur
Bottoms and four whales. Lat 36-43 Long 75-52.

Remarks Wednesday March 13th.

Begin with fresh Breezes from the W and
thick weather. Latter part Moderate.
Lat 37-18 Long 76-11

Remarks Thursday March 14th.

Begin with Moderate Breezes from W. Spoke
the Dark Matilda Seal & Sea Fox.
Latter part Moderate. Lat 36-56 Long 76-15

Remarks Friday March 15th.

Begin with pleasant Breezes from W.
Latter part fresh Breezes from W by N.
Lat 37-01 Long 76-52

Begin with strong winds from W by N and squalls of rain.
at 13 P.M. Double reefed. at 5 Wind S by W. Latter part strong
with strong with heavy squalls, under close reef.

Remarks Sunday March 17th.

Begin with strong from S by W. under close reef. Latter
part fresh Breezes from S by E. Saw five whales.

Lat 37-25 Long 76-28

Remarks Monday March 18th.

Begin with fresh Breezes and fine. Saw five whales.
Latter part strong Breezes from S by E. under close reef. Pop
sail. Lat 37-17 Long 76-02

Remarks Tuesday March 19th.

Begin with strong winds from the S by E and ruggles. Saw
Whale of P. West. Latter part fresh Breezes from Breezes from S.
Lat 37-09 Long 75-26

Remarks Wednesday March 20th.

Begin with light Breezes from S by E. Spoke the Matilda.
Middle part Calm. Latter part fresh Breezes from S by W. Latter
part S by W. no Ob.

Remarks Thursday March 21st.

Begin with strong winds from N by N and thick
weather. Saw Whale of P. West Cutting a whale.
Latter part Moderate and thick. Lat 37-21 Long 76-39

Remarks Friday March 22nd.

Begin with Moderate Breezes from W by S
and thick weather. Latter part Calm and foggy.
Lat 37-04 Long 77-06

Remarks Saturday March 23rd.

Begin with light air from S. Seven whales
in sight and one three masted schooner. Spoke
the Sea Fox. Latter part fresh Breezes and
thick weather. Lat 37-05

Remarks Sunday March 24th.

Begin with strong winds from the S. Spoke
Whale of P. Allen, Lucretia, Sea Fox, and Matilda.
Latter part Moderate from S by W. Steering to the
Eastward. Lat 36-57 Long 76-36
