Remarks Wednesday May 1st 1878
Begin with light breezes from S.E. and fine weather. Spoke the Nautilus. Latter part moderate breezes from E.S.E. steering N.W. saw squid

Remarks Thursday May 2nd
Begin with moderate breezes from E.S.E.
Spoke the Nautilus. Latter part moderate. repaired the broken top mast stay sail.
Lat 33-29 Long 81-17

Remarks Friday May 3rd
Begin with moderate breezes from S.E. Massafuera in sight bearing S.E. dist 6 miles. Latter part moderate breezes from W. steering S.E. for Massafuera.
Lat 32-21

Remarks Saturday May 4th
Begin with fresh breezes from W by N. steering S.E. Massafuera bearing S.E. dist 36 miles. at 6 P.M. the Bark Pintero, English passed abeam to starboard. Middle part strong winds and rainy. Latter part wind S.W. and clearing weather.

Remarks Sunday May 5th
Begin with strong winds from S.W. under double reef. at 5 P.M. Massafuera bearing S. dist 40 miles. Latter part fresh breezes from the S. Course W by S.

Remarks Monday May 6th
Begin with pleasant breezes from S.E. Course W by N. at 5 P.M. heaved to head to N.E. Latter part moderate. steering W. N.W.
Lat 32-39 Long 81-59

Remarks Tuesday May 7th
Begin with moderate breezes from S.E. steering W. N.W. Latter part strong breezes from S.W. and flew with a heavy swell.

Remarks Wednesday May 8th 1878.
Begin with fresh breezes from S.W. with a heavy swell. Latter part light breezes and flew from S.E.
Lat 31-39 Long 82-27

Remarks Thursday May 9th
Begin with light airs from S.E. with a heavy swell. Latter part light breezes from S.W. saw Pin Backs.
Lat 31-54 Long 82-08

Remarks Friday May 10th
Begin with light breezes from the S. saw Pin Backs. Latter part light breezes from the S. with big squalls.
Lat 32-08 Long 82-00

Remarks Saturday May 11th
Begin with light breezes from the S. with big squalls. saw Pin Backs. Latter part fresh breezes from S.W. saw a whaling bark.
Lat 32-44 Long 81-05

Remarks Sunday May 12th
Begin with fresh breezes from S.W. at 3 hauled to the south in a squall. saw three whales. Latter part strong wind from S.E. 2 whales in sight.

Remarks Monday May 13th
Begin with fresh breezes from E by S. spoke the James Allen & Nautilus. Latter part fresh breezes from E by S to E.S.E. and heavy S.W. swell. saw four whales.
Lat 33-39 Long 82-20

Remarks Tuesday May 14th
Begin with fresh breezes from the E by N. saw five whales. We have 5 men forward sick & off duty. Latter part fresh breezes. The sick men about the same. One has a fever, one dysentery, one stomach, and one something else.

Remarks Wednesday May 15th
Begin with fresh breezes from E. Latter part moderate. saw two whales.
