Begins with a gale from the N. and rain. At 5th P.M. wind hauled in a squall to the W. & W. Latter part wind from S.W. to N.W. and rain. Saw one sail, supposed it the J. A. Maculand. No Obs.

Remarks Monday May 27th.

Begins with fresh breezes from the N.W. by W. and a heavy westerly swell. passed the Maritime Middle and latter parts strong winds and heavy squalls under close reef. repairing mizen top sail. Saw the N. D. Billow.

Remarks Tuesday May 28th.

Begins with a fresh Gale from S.W. by W. to W. with heavy squalls. Under close reef. Saw Bin & Backs battering. Latter part strong winds from W. & W. with breeches. and one sail.

Remarks Wednesday May 29th.

Begins with strong winds from W. & W. squally and ruggled. Middle part a Gale. Latter part more moderate.

Lat-32=14 Long 82=05

Remarks Thursday May 30th.

Begins with fresh breezes from S.W. but heavy swell. Latter part moderate and rainy. Wind from E. to W.

Remarks Friday May 31st.

Begins with fresh breezes from N.W. and rainy. Wind hauled S. by E. and increased. Appearance of another gale. Middle part a gale from the N. at 6 A.M. cleared off and came out to the S. & S. and blew very heavy until 7 A.M. then began to moderate. Bar 29.5/10

Remarks Saturday June 1st Mth.

Begins with a gale from the S. have too head to the W. & W. under a close reefed main top sail. Bar 29.5/10 Latter part moderate. all sail set the first time for 10 days. overhauled the cutting top sail. made them 12 parts of new line.

Remarks Sunday June 2nd.

Begins with light breezes from S. by E. and a heavy southerly swell. One sail in sight. Latter part fresh breezes from N.E. steering W. by N. saw a merchant bark.

Remarks Monday June 3rd.

Begins with fresh breezes from N.E. and increasing. at 11 P.M. began to rain. close reef and furled fore sail. has appearance of another gale. Latter part strong winds from the N. and thick weather. under two close reef.

Begins with a moderate gale from the N.W. by N. under close reef. head to the N. saw a ship heading to the S. & W. Latter part much the same weather.
