Begin with fresh breeze from N.W. by W. head to the N.E. Latter part light air and Calm. Lat 25-11 Long 84-19

Remarks Monday June 10<sup>th</sup>  
Begin with light air and Calm. Latter part light and baffling. Lat 24-46 Long 84-15

Remarks Tuesday June 11<sup>th</sup>  
Begin with light air and baffling from N. to N.W. Latter part the same kind of winds. Saw a sail. Lat 23-43 Long 84-22

Remarks Wednesday June 12<sup>th</sup>  
Begin with light winds and baffling from W. to N.W. Latter part light air and Calm. Lat 23-02 Long 84-12

Remarks Thursday June 13<sup>th</sup>  
Begin with light from the N. and Calm. Latter part Calm. Lat 22-48 Long 84-00

Remarks Friday June 14<sup>th</sup>  
Begin with light and Calm. Latter part Calm. Saw Sulphur Bottom. Lat 22-25 Long 84-09

Remarks Saturday June 15<sup>th</sup>  
Begin with light breeze from S.E. Course N.W. by W. Latter part fresh trades from S.E. by E. repaired the fly jib. Lat 20-44 Long 83-48

Remarks Sunday June 16<sup>th</sup>  
Begin with fresh trades Course W. by N. Latter part strong trades and squally. Lat 19-28 Long 83-14

Remarks Monday June 17<sup>th</sup>  
Begin with strong trades Course W. by N. at 5 1/2. No huffed too hard to the S. Latter part strong winds. Under double reef. Lat 19-44 Long 83-33

Begin with strong winds from S.E. Under double reef. Main top sail & close reefed. Latter part same winds. Course N.W. Lat 19-16 Long 80-08

Begin with strong winds Course N.W. saw bristles ran for it, but saw no more of it. at sun down huffed too. Latter part more moderate. Saw Sulphur Bottom. Lat 18-47 Long 80-47

Remarks Thursday June 20<sup>th</sup>  
Begin with moderate trades. Steering S.W. by W. saw fin backs. at sundown huffed too. Latter part fresh trades. Steering. Lat 19-02

Remarks Friday June 21<sup>st</sup>  
Begin with fresh trades. Spoke the Daunting. Bittow. Latter part strong trades and squally. Lat 18-11 Long 81-33

Remarks Saturday June 22<sup>nd</sup>  
Begin with strong trades from E. and squally. Latter part fresh trades. repaired the jib. Saw Sulphur Bottom. Lat 18-38 Long 82-18

Remarks Sunday June 23<sup>rd</sup>  
Begin with fresh trades. Saw Sulphur Bottom. the B.B. Bittow still in sight. Latter fresh trades and squally. Lat 19-04 Long 82-57
