Remarks Wednesday 26th 1878.

Begins with strong trades and squally. Latter part strong trades under double reefed main top sail. Close reefed fore and bare sail. The dismasting billow ran off out of sight. She has been in sight 6 days.

Remarks Thursday June 27th

Begins with strong trades from E by S. and small sail. Latter part strong winds. Lat 18-33 Long 93-38

Remarks Friday June 28th

Begins with strong trades and squally. Latter part more moderate. Employed repairing the main top sail. Lat 18-25 Long 93-46

Remarks Saturday June 29th

Begins with fresh trades. Employed repairing the main top sail. Latter part strong winds and squally. finished and bent the main top sail. Lat 18-22 Long 93-40

Remarks Sunday June 30th

Begins with strong trades and squally. Latter part strong winds Lat 18-34 Long 93-57

Remarks Monday July 1st 1878

Begins with strong trades and squally. Latter part strong winds. Lat

Remarks Tuesday July 2nd

Begins with strong trades and squally. Latter part the same kind of weather.

Lat 18-36 Long 94-26

Remarks Wednesday July 3rd

Begins with strong trades and squally. Saw sulphur bottom. Latter part strong winds. Employed repairing the spanker.

Lat 19-26 Long 94-46

Remarks Thursday July 4th 1878.

Begins with strong winds. Under double reefed main top sail. Close reefed fore. Latter part strong and squally. finished the spanker.

Lat 20-06 Long 94-53

Remarks Friday July 5th

Begins strong trades and squally under double reefed main top sail. Close reefed fore. Latter part the same.

Lat 19-42 Long 95-00

Remarks Saturday July 6th

Begins with strong trades. Saw Pin. backs. Latter part the same. repairing the fore sail.

Lat 19-49 no obs

Remarks Sunday July 7th

Begins with strong trades. Latter part fresh trades.

Lat 19-28 Long 94-57

Remarks Monday July 8th

Begins with fresh trades. Lat 18-34 P. No visible sperm whales 2 pairs off the line. Saw, going very quick to the windward. in a half hour they were 3 miles off the weather beam. then it was sun down. did not lower.

Latter part strong winds and squally. repairing the fore sail.

Lat 19-35

Remarks Tuesday July 9th

Begins with strong winds and squally. repairing the fore sail. Latter part squally. finished and bent the fore sail.

Lat 19-34 Long 94-32

Remarks Wednesday July 10th

Begins with strong trades. Latter part more moderate. Saw oil-squid
