Remarks Tuesday July 23rd 1878
Begins with fresh breezes from S & W and
Squalls. Course S & by E. Middle part blew on to a
gale. At 2 1/2 P.M. hove to under close reefed main
top sail head to the S & E, latter part the same.

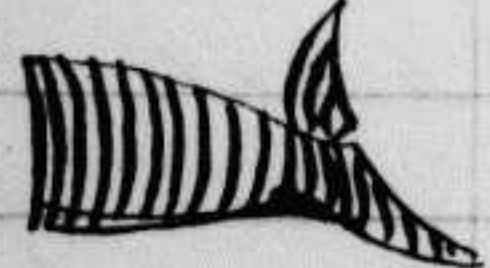
Lat 27-27 Long 86-36

Remarks Wednesday July 24th
Begins with a gale from W & W under close
reef. Latter part more moderate. Wind S & E.

Lat 29-57 Long 85-42

Remarks Thursday July 25th
Begins with fresh breezes from S & by S and
a heavy S & W swell. Hove a sail. Latter part light
air. Saw two Merchant Barks.

Lat 29-31 Long 84-42



Remarks Friday July 26th
Begins with a Calm. At 1 P.M. raised a school
of 11 m. Whales going S & E quite quick. At 1 3/4
o'clock lowered the boats. At 4 o'clock the
main boat went on and fastened slightly
and allowed the Iran. Chased until sundown
and returned to the ship with nothing.
Latter part Calm. At 2 P.M. raised whales
off the port beam way in the horizon. 8 miles
off. Saw three risings. did no lower.

Lat 29-28 Long 84-45



Remarks Saturday July 27th
Begins with a Calm. at 3 1/2 P.M. raised
three large Whales four miles off coming
toward the ship. at 4 o'clock 15 minutes
lowered the boats. with one hour sun to
work in. at 5 1/2 the boat went on head
and head. the whale perceived the boat
and settled. so that is all of that. What luck.
Latter part Calm. 5 sails in
light. no obs.

Remarks Sunday July 28th 1878
Begins with Calm. At 6 took a light air
from N & W. Course S & E. Latter part light air.
Saw Sulphur bolams. I put one of my Cakes for Supper. it
was a good as new.

Lat 27-57 Long 84-21

Remarks Monday July 29th

Begins with moderate breezes from N. Course
S & E. Latter part moderate breezes from N & W. Saw
a large body of Bin. Barks. and a whaler. Called her
the Steamboat.

Lat 30-57 Long 83-27

Remarks Tuesday July 30th

Begins with moderate breezes from N & W Course
S & by S. Latter part fresh breezes from N & W.

Lat 32-35 Long 83-11

Remarks Wednesday July 31st

Begins with strong winds from N & by N. at 12
noon luffed too head to the W. Latter part a moderate
gale. and a heavy S & W swell.

Lat 32-24 Long 82-59

Remarks Thursday August 1st

Begins with fresh breezes from W & N and
a heavy S & W swell. Latter part fresh breezes from
N & W. Steering N & by E.

Lat 32-20 Long 81-52

Remarks Friday August 2nd

Begins with strong breezes from N & W.
Latter part strong winds from N & by W. under
two double reefs. Bar 29.740. no obs.

Remarks Saturday August 3rd

Begins with a moderate gale from N & by W
and increasing. at 3 1/2 P.M. began to rain
close reefed. At 4 1/2 P.M. wore ship to the N & E
and hove to under close reefed main top sail.
at 6 wind began to haul. Bar 29.580.

Middle part a gale from W & N to S & by W.
Latter part little more moderate. but heavy squalls.
