saw the Stamboul Baiting. Latter part
moderate breezes from W S W. Course S E.

Remarks Monday Oct 7th 1878.
Begin with moderate breezes from the
westward and thick weather. Latter part
strong winds from W by N. under two double
reef & bare sail. saw blump backs.

Lat 36-29 Long 75-14

Remarks Tuesday Oct 8th 1878.
Begin with strong winds from W by S.
under double reef. Latter part strong winds
and a heavy swell.

Lat 36-07 Long 75-25

Remarks Wednesday Oct 9th 1878.
Begin with strong winds from the westward
and a heavy swell. Latter part light air and
calm. saw three sails.

Remarks Thursday Oct 10th 1878.
Begin with light breeze from W. S. W. saw fin
backs. Latter part light breezes and foggy.

Lat 36-26 Long 75-19

Remarks Friday Oct 11th 1878.
Begin with light breezes from S W. Spoke the
Nautilus. saw fin backs. Latter part pleasant
breezes from S by W.

Begin with fresh breezes from S W. Oh dear

moderate from S by W.

wired hauled to the S W. took in main sail, jib
& spanker and double reef. saw backs of
winthrop and Nautilus. Latter part squally
up to 9 A M. then light with a heavy swell.

heavy swell from S W. Latter part strong winds
from W by N and thick weather. no Cal

Latter part baffling and foggy. saw
porpoises and crampuses. Two whales
in sight.
