

Remarks Thursday Oct 24th 1878
Begin with light air and baffling with
fog. Latter part moderate from W SW with
fog squalls. Spoke the Nautilus and Matilda.

Remarks Friday Oct 25th
Begin with strong winds from S W and
squally. Sauble reefed. at 6 P. No. Close reefed.
Latter part strong winds from S E. under
close reefed and spanker. Lat 36-16 Long 74-49

Remarks Saturday Oct 26th
Begin with strong winds from S E. under
close reef. saw fin backs. Latter part strong
winds from S E. under close reef and stay sails
Lat 36-15 Long 75-42

Remarks Sunday Oct 27th
Begin with strong winds from S E by S. under
close reef and stay sails. Nautilus in sight.
Latter part moderate from S W Lat 36-13 Long 75-00

Remarks Monday Oct 28th
Begin with light breezes from S W to W.
The Matilda in sight. Latter part moderate
breezes from the N. Lat 36-35 Long 75-06

Remarks Tuesday Oct 29th
Begin with fresh breezes from the N.
The Matilda in sight. Saw No. Backs.
Latter part strong from the N and heavy.
under close reef. No Ob

Remarks Wednesday Oct 30th
Begin with strong winds from the N.
under close reef. Latter part strong
winds from N W with a heavy swell
and thick weather Lat 37-13 Long 75-43

Remarks Thursday Oct 31st 1878
Begin with moderate breezes from N W
and a heavy swell. Latter part strong winds
from N W by W and squally. Steering N E by E.
No Ob

Remarks Friday Nov 1st
Begin with strong winds from N W by W and
squally. heading to the N. Latter part moderate
breezes from the westward. at 4 P. No. raised the
land bearing N E by E. the high land of St. Mary's
course N E by N 1/2 N. thro about 15 miles to the westward.
Lat 37-06 Long 74-26

Remarks Saturday Nov 2nd
Begin with moderate breezes from N W by W.
steering toward Palcahuano. at 3 P. No. raised
St. Mary's. at 4 saw the Cape of San Diego.
steering N E by E 1/2 E. at 7 P. No. bent the chain.
Cape bearing E N E by Camp. St. Mary's
bearing E by S Dist 15 miles. Latter part calm.
at noon Plumbe's Point bearing N E by E Dist 15 miles
Lat 36-37 Long 73-20

Remarks Sunday Nov 3rd
Begin with calm. at 13 P. No. took a light air from
S W. Steering in for Palcahuano; at 7 P. No. Plumbe's
Point bearing S Dist 2 miles. N end of Buerguina
bearing E N Dist 3 miles. Latter part calm. at
midnight passed Buiriquina. at 3 A. No. commenced to
tow the bark in. towed until 6 1/2 A. No. at 8 began to
tow again, towed until 10 1/2 then came to anchor
in the harbour of Palcahuano in 5 fathoms water. off
shag rock.

Remarks Wednesday Nov 20th
at 2 P. No. took the anchor and sailed from
Palcahuano. with a light breeze from S W.
