Begin with moderate breezes from S.E. by S. Saw fair harpaises. Latter part pleasant breezes from S.E. at 11 A.M. raised a school of large whales going to the leeward. at 11^{1/2} lowered the boats. No ends, boats chasing. Lat 42-15 Long 76-05

Remarks Monday Jan 6th

Begin with fresh breezes from the S.E. Boats chasing. at 13^{1/4} P.M. the 8th boat struck. at 2^{3/4} took him along side. at 5 commenced cutting. cut the head part off and threw in the jaw. at 8 lashed down for the night. Latter part pleasant. at 5 A.M. began cutting. at noon had the body in. Lat 42-47 Long 76-14

Remarks Tuesday Jan 7th

Begin with moderate breezes from S.E. employed cutting. at 7^{1/2} P.M. finished. had a very good time to cut. at 8 commenced dailing. Latter part fresh breezes from S.W. Lat 41-22 Long 76-36

Remarks Wednesday Jan 8th

Begin with fresh breezes from the W and increasing employed dailing. at 8 P.M. commenced to rain slowly. under close reef. Latter part moderate gale from S.W. employed dailing. Lat 41-55 Long 76-27

Remarks Thursday Jan 9th

Begin with strong winds from the S.W. and rugged. employed dailing. at 11 finished dailing. at 8 A.M. commenced to stow the head down. Lat 42-05 Long 76-19

Remarks Friday Jan 10th

fresh breeze and a heavy swell. at 11 A.M. finished stowing down. Hauled 90 8th lbs. Lat 42-04 Long 76-04

Remarks Saturday Jan 11th 1877

Begin with light breezes from S.W. and a heavy S.W. swell. Latter part moderate. saw 8th whales. Lat 42-22 Long 76-00

Remarks Sunday Jan 12th

Begin with light breezes from W.S.W. saw harpaiser. Latter part fresh breezes from W.N.W. at 8^{1/2} A.M. raised a sperm whale going S.E. lowered the boats. 8th harpaiser turned him to the windward. at noon boats chasing. Lat 42-27 Long 76-07

Remarks Monday Jan 13th

Begin with fresh breezes from W. by S. boats chasing the whale. at 2^{1/2} P.M. returned to the ship. no success. Latter part strong winds and thick weather under close reef. No Cal.

Remarks Tuesday Jan 14th

Begin with strong winds from W. and rainy under close reef. at 2^{1/2} P.M. wind hauled to the S.W. Latter part a gale from S.W. under close reef main top sail and stay sails. Lat 42-17 Long 76-25

Remarks Wednesday Jan 15th

Begin with a gale from S.W. under close reef main top sail and stay sails. Latter part strong winds from W.S.W. under double reef. Lat 42-48 Long 75-49

Remarks Thursday Jan 16th

Begin with strong winds from W.S.W. under double reef. Latter part strong winds and a heavy swell. Lat 43-06 Long 75-42

Remarks Friday Jan 17th

Begin with strong winds from W. and a heavy S.W. swell. under double reef. Latter part a gale from W.S.W. have too head to the S.W. under close reef main top sail and stay sails. No Cal.
