Remarks Saturday Jan 18th 1877.
Begin with a gale from the W and thick
with a heavy sea. Have to head to the S.W.
under close reefed main top sail and stay sails.
Latter part more moderate. Saw a steamer
and a whaling bark. Lat 44-24 Long 76-10

Remarks Sunday Jan 19th
Begin with strong breezes from W. and
thick with a heavy S.W. swell. Spoke the
S.A. Howland. Latter part moderate and thick
from the W. Spoke the bark Lucretia.
Lat 44-25 Long 76-01

Remarks Monday Jan 20th
Begin with moderate breezes from W and
thick weather with a heavy S.W. swell.
Middle part light winds and a thick fog.
Latter part cleared off at 10 took a light
breeze from S. two whales in sight.
Lat 44-37 Long 75-54

Remarks Tuesday Jan 21st
Begin with moderate breezes from S.
steering to the N. at 6 set in foggy. luffed to.
Latter pleasant breezes from S by W. at 9 A.M.
fog cleared off. two whales in sight. saw 80 fish.
Lat 44-03 Long 75-50

Remarks Wednesday Jan 22nd
Begin with pleasant breezes from S by W.
steering N.E. for the land. at 4 P.M. raised
Huaso. at 7 1/2 P.M. set in foggy. luffed to
heading W by S. Huaso bearing N.E. by E. 20
miles. Dist 7 whales in sight.
Latter moderate breezes from the S.W. and foggy.
Spoke the Stamboul Lat 43-35 Long 75-54

Remarks Thursday Jan 23rd
Begin with moderate breezes from the W.
Latter part fresh breezes from S by E and
thick weather

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Remarks Friday Jan 24th 1877
Begin with strong winds from S.E. and rainy.
Spoke the bark Allen. Latter part fresh breezes
and thick weather. No wh

Remarks Saturday Jan 25th
Begin with fresh breezes from S.E. by E and thick
weather. Latter part moderate from E.S.E. and thick.
at 11 A.M. cleared off. Lat 43-35 Long 75-20

Remarks Sunday Jan 26th
Begin with pleasant breezes from S.E. at 7 P.M.
Huaso bearing E by N. Dist 30 miles. Spoke the Sancer.
Latter part strong winds from S.W.
Lat 43-48 Long 75-56

Remarks Monday Jan 27th
Begin with strong winds from S by W saw four
whales. the S.A. Howland. fireh Perry. Stamboul & Milton
Latter part strong winds from S by W and rigger.
Lat 43-26 Long 75-37

Remarks Tuesday Jan 28th
Begin with strong winds from S with heavy
squalls and increasing. at 5 1/2 P.M. close reefed and furled
the bare sail. six whales in sight. Noelle and
Latter part fresh gales and heavy squalls.
Lat 43-16 Long 75-56

Remarks Wednesday Jan 29th
Begin with a fresh gale from S by W
with a rough sea. Latter part light breezes
from S.W. to W. Lat 43-46 no wh

Remarks Thursday Jan 30th
Begin with light breezes from W.S.W. and
thick weather. Spoke the Stamboul.
Latter part strong winds. Lat 43-16 Long 75-36

Remarks Friday Jan 31st
Strong winds and squally. Spoke the
bark Allen Stamboul and Saundling Belcan.
