Remarks Saturday Feb 1st 1879

Begins with a gale from N by W under close reef bracing to the S W. Latter part strong winds under close reef & bare sail. No Cal

Remarks Sunday Feb 2nd

Begins with strong winds from the Westward and a rough sea. Latter part strong winds from W N W under double reef. Saw 3 Whalers.

Lat 44=10 Long 76=05

Remarks Monday Feb 3rd

Begins with strong winds from N W and thick weather. at 7 P M close reef. Saw three Whalers. Latter part strong winds from W N W with a very low Barometer 29 4/10

Lat 44=37 Long 76=42

Remarks Tuesday Feb 4th

Begins with strong winds from W N W. at 4 1/2 P M began to rain at 6 Wind S W by W light Bar 29 4/10. Latter part fresh breezes and rugged with squalls Saw six Whalers.

Lat 43=54 Long 76=02

Remarks Wednesday Feb 5th

Begins with fresh breezes from W and squalls with a heavy S W swell. Bar Barometer 29 5/10. Latter part fresh breezes at 7 A M the wind hauled to the S in a squall.

Lat 42=53 Long 75=40

Remarks Thursday Feb 6th

Begins with fresh breezes from S. under double reef. at 6-10 P M saw a Breach. Latter part moderate at 1 A M parted Dead eye Strap that the main stay sets up to. at 5 1/2 A M raised a lane whale going E N E slow lowered the boats the whale turned to the landward for same cause with him to us. so ends Chasing.

Lat 42=45 Long 75=31

Remarks Friday Feb 7th

light air. Boats Chasing. at 3 P M gave up the chase. Latter part moderate saw the Milton Steer N

Lat 42=37 Long 75=20

Remarks Saturday Feb 8th 1879

Begins with pleasant breeze from S W by W. saw Black Bish. Killers, Hump Back fin. Backs & Porpoises, and the Land Dist 45 Miles. Latter part moderate and thick. Lat 42=39 Long 75=43

Remarks Sunday Feb 9th

Begins with calm and light air from W by N. Latter part moderate breezes from W N W.

Lat 42=29 Long 75=34

Remarks Monday Feb 10th

Begins with moderate breezes from W N W. Latter part moderate breezes from S W and a heavy S W swell.

Lat 42=56 Long 75=42

Remarks Tuesday Feb 11th

First part moderate breezes from S W and a heavy S W swell. Saw Hump Back and black Bish. Latter part calm. made the fibb smaller. took off 25 yards.

Lat 42=44 Long 75=31

Remarks Wednesday Feb 12th

First part light air and calm finished and bent the fibb. Latter part calm and light air from N. repaired the Fore Mast Stay Sail.

Lat 42=56. not

Remarks Thursday Feb 13th

First part moderate breezes from N N W. repaired the main topmast stay sail. Latter part moderate breezes from S W.

Lat 42=34 Long 75=37

Remarks Friday Feb 14th

First part light breezes from S W and hauling to the west at 1 1/2 P M raised a large whale. at 2 1/2 lowered the boats. at 5 1/2 the W Boat struck. He was a bad whale. would not let a Boat come near him. the Boat Steerer set him to spouting blood with a Peices Samb Lance. But for that he would have used up all the boats. He then the L Boat. He died at 11 O Clock at night. got him along side exposed the Chain on him at 1 1/2 in the morning. Latter part a Gale of wind to cut. gave it up. put all our chains and a blower on him. Lat 42=27 Long 75=21
