First part - a Gale from the land and rain. Have too under close reefed main top sail and after sails. Bar. 29.40
 Latter part moderate breezes from W. and a heavy swell.

Remarks Sunday March 2nd

First part light breezes from W with a heavy swell. weather unsettled. Bar 29.40 Latter part fresh breezes from N.W. saw the Ship William and Bark Stamboul. Lat 42-18 Long 75-54

Remarks Monday March 3rd

First part fresh breezes from N.W. and increasing at 5 P.M. began to rain. Close reefed the top sails. Bar 29.65. Latter part fresh breezes and thick weather.

Lat 42-09 Long 75-57

Remarks Tuesday March 4th

First part light breezes from N.W. and thick weather. Latter part light breezes from W.N.W. and a heavy swell from S.W.

Lat 41-56 Long 75-47

Remarks Wednesday March 5th

First part light air from S.W. and Calm. Latter part light breezes from N.W. Lat 41-58 Long 75-21

Remarks Thursday March 6th

First part light breezes from N.W. spoke the Stamboul. Latter part light air and Calm. Lat 42-14 Long 75-40

Remarks Friday March 7th

First part light breezes from S.W. to S. saw Porpoises. Latter part light breezes from S. Land in sight. Dist 30 miles. Lat 42-24 Long 75-00

Remarks Saturday March 8th

First part moderate breezes from S.W. by S. Land Dist 30 miles. saw bump. backs. on a steamer. Latter part moderate breezes from W.N.W. and thick weather at 10 P.M. vessel hauled to the S. Stamboul in sight.

Lat 42-11 Long 75-05

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Remarks Sunday March 9th 1877

First part light breezes from the S. with fog & squalls. saw 160 ducks. Stamboul in sight.

Latter part light breezes from S.E. Chiloe in sight. Dist 35 miles. Lat 42-02 Long 75-15

Remarks Monday March 10th

First part light air from S and Calm. a heavy swell. Chiloe in sight. Dist 40 miles. Latter part fresh breezes from N.W. at 11 P.M. began to rain. no bar

Remarks Tuesday March 11th

First part fresh winds from W and rain. Latter part light breezes from the S. Lat 42-03 Long 75-59

Remarks Wednesday March 12th

First part light air and Calm. with a heavy swell. Latter part fresh breezes from N.W. during S.E.

Lat 42-22 Long 75-47

Remarks Thursday March 13th
 First part fresh breezes from N.W. by S. at 5 P.M. raised two large whales going quick to the windward. toward the boats but it was dark before the whales came up again. got nothing. Latter part Calm.

Lat 42-34 Long 75-17

Remarks Friday March 14th

First part light air from S.W. and Calm. Latter part light breezes from S.W. and foggy.

Lat 42-36 Long 75-13

Remarks Saturday March 15th

First part moderate breezes from S.W. Latter part strong winds from the S. under close reef. saw 83 fish. Lat 42-35 Long 75-57

Remarks Sunday March 16th

First part strong winds from S. under close reef. Latter part strong winds. saw Porpoises
