Remarks Tuesday April 1st
First part moderate breezes from S. spoke the Napoleon.

Lat 37-13 Long 76-04

Remarks Wednesday April 2nd
First part light air from the N. spoke the Napoleon
& caught 11 Hops & remainder far back. Raised 59-60 for them.
Latter part strong barter. at 11 wind W & W.

Lat 36-42 Long 75-50

Remarks Thursday April 3rd
First part strong winds from S & by W. Under close reef.
Napoleon in sight. Latter part strong winds from S & W
to S. and heavy squalls. at 10 1/2 A M put off E & N E.

Lat 36-53 Long 76-02

Remarks Friday April 4th
First part fresh breezes from S & by S. steering 6 by N
1/2 N. at 6 P M spoke the course for Palcahuano
& by E. Bombez went Dist 45 miles. The Napoleon
in sight. Latter part moderate at noon
passed Quiriquina. at 3 1/2 P M shared.

Remarks Tuesday May 6th
Fresh breezes from the S. at
10 1/2 A M took our anchor and sailed
from Palcahuano. passed out of the
small passage.

Remarks Wednesday 7th
First part fresh breezes from S.
steering W by N for Juan. Latter part
light air. at 11 1/2 A M raised a land
whale going quick to the N & W.
hauled without success did not
get near enough to see out of the
boats.

Remarks Thursday May 8th 1877
First part light air at Calma. steering W
by N. Latter part light breezes from the N.

Lat 35-01 Long 76-11

Remarks Friday May 9th
First part fresh breezes from the N. steering W by N.
at night double reef. Latter part a gale from the
N. at 11 1/2 A M wind hauled to the N.

Lat 34-57 Long 77-33

Remarks Saturday May 10th
First part a gale from the W & W. heading N W.
under close reef. Latter part light and baffling from
S to W. with a heavy S W swell.

Lat 34-21 Long 77-41

Remarks Sunday May 11th
First part light breezes from W & W to N W
and heavy S W swell. trying to get to Juan for
wood. Middle part wind W & W and squally.
Latter part wind S & by S and squally. head W by N.

Lat 34-10 Long 78-10

Remarks Monday May 12th
First part fresh breezes from S & W heading
W by N. at 12 P M raised Juan bearing W by
N 1/2 N Dist 40 miles. at 6 P M Dist 20 miles.
Latter part fresh breezes from S E. Bark off and
on Juan for wood. The 83 Billow there too.

Remarks Tuesday May 13th
First part fresh breezes from S E. Bark
off and on for wood at Juan. got off 6
cords and at 6 1/2 P M put away for the
N. Course N. Latter part fresh breezes.
