First part fresh breezes from S & E Course
N & by N. Latter part fresh breezes, at 9 A.M.
ran into a school of small whales. lowered the
boats. the S boat struck. at noon took the
whale along side. the S & W boats chasing.
Lat 26-47 Long 75-52

Remarks Friday May 16th
First part moderate. Two boats chasing
whales. the W boat struck. the S boat
drewed. took the W boat whale along
side at 4 P.M. Cut one in. Latter part
Calm. at 10 A.M. finished cutting the other whale.
Lat 26-33 Long 75-50

Remarks Saturday May 17th
First part light airs from the NW. at 1 1/2 P.M.
commenced hailing. Latter part light air
from NW. Employed hailing.
Lat 26-16 Long 76-18

Remarks Sunday May 18th
First part light air from the westward
Course N.E. at 1 P.M. finished hailing. the
whales turned up 33 whls. Latter part light
air from S.W. Lat 25-39 Long 74-32

Remarks Monday May 19th
First part light air from S.W. to S.E.
Course N & by E. Latter part light air and
hailing from S.E. to N.W.
Lat 25-22 Long 73-50

Remarks Tuesday May 20th
First part light air and Calm. Latter part
moderate breezes from the N. Employed stowing
down oil. Stowed 44 bbls. Lat 25-15 Long 72-50

Remarks Wednesday May 21st
First light air from N. heading to the Eastward.
Latter part light air and hailing. Land in
sight Dist 80 miles. Lat 24-04 Long 72-14

Remarks Thursday May 22nd 1879
First part light air from NW. Land in sight.
Latter part fresh breezes from S. Steering N.E.
Lat 23-47 Long 71-28

Remarks Friday May 23rd
First part fresh breezes from S by W. Course
N.E. Land at 6 P.M. Dist 30 miles. Latter part
light breezes from S. running down the Land off
Chile. Dist about 10 miles.
Lat 22-27 Long 70-28

Remarks Saturday May 24th
First part fresh breeze from S. Course N. along
the Land. Dist 8 miles. Saw three bars. Chile
Algodon and another small place. Saw four war
steamers. There is war now between Chile, Peru
and Bolivia. the two latter power against Chile.
Latter part Calm. at 8 A.M. Land in sight.
Dist 30 miles. A heavy S.W. swell.
Lat 20-22 Long 70-56

Remarks Sunday May 25th
First part light air and Calm. Course W. & N.W.
A heavy S.W. swell. Latter part light breezes
from S.W. Lat 20-10 Long 71-28

Remarks Monday May 26th
First part moderate breezes from S & E
Course W. & by S. Latter part moderate breezes
from S & by S. Employed repairing fore sail.
Lat 19-03 Long 73-24

Remarks Tuesday May 27th
First part fresh breezes from S & by S. repairing
fore sail. Latter part moderate. Course W by N
& S. Lat 18-22 No Obs.

Remarks Wednesday May 28th
First part moderate breezes from S & by S.
Course W by N. repairing the fore sail.
Latter part moderate. finished the
fore sail.
No Obs.
