Remarks Tuesday June 24th.
First part Calm & strong S.W. Current.
Latter part light air from S.E. heading S.W.
Lat 1-18 Long 96-56

Remarks Wednesday June 25th.
First part light air from S.E. heading by to
the S.W. two sails in sight. Middle & latter parts
moderate from S.W. to S.E. the Lucretia in
sight. Lat 1-14 Long 97-00

Remarks Thursday June 26th.
First part light breezes from S.E. heading
by to the S.W. there is still a strong S.W.
Current. With a breeze of 2 or 3 knots
we make northward. Latter part moderate.
Lat 00-58 Long 97-43

Remarks Friday June 27th.
First part fresh breezes from S.E. heading
by to the S.W. under full sail. Latter part
fresh breezes. the Lucretia in sight.
Lat 00-06 Long 99-12

Remarks Saturday June 28th.
First part moderate breeze from S.E.
heading by to the S.W. Latter part moderate
at 6 1/2 A.M. tacked to the Eastward.
Lat 00-42 Long 99-51

Remarks Sunday June 29th.
First part light breezes from S.E. by S. heading
by to the Eastward. Latter part light breezes
saw a strange whaling bark. Lat 00-16 Long 99-06

Remarks Monday June 30th.
First part light air. Latter part light air
steering N.E. by E. Lat 00-24 Long 99-26

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Remarks Monday July 1st 1879.
First part light breezes from S.E. by S.
Course N.E. by E. at sundown luffed 100.
Latter part light air and thick weather.
Lat 00-07 Long 99-13

Remarks Tuesday July 2nd.
First part light air from S.E. Course N.E. by
S. Latter part light breezes. Lat 00-12 Long 100-09

Remarks Wednesday Thursday July 3rd.
First part light breezes from S.E. Course N.E. by
S. Latter part fresh breezes, put up the new
wane and fly. Lat 00-08 Long 101-35

Remarks Friday July 4th.
First part fresh breezes. Course W. by S.
at 6 A.M. luffed 100. made the S.W.
Latter part fresh breezes. Lat 00-46 Long 103-17

Remarks Saturday July 5th.
First part fresh breezes from S.E. heading
by the wind to the S.W. Latter part fresh
breezes. took in the main top gall sail. the first
time for a month. Lat 2-45 Long 104-37

Remarks Sunday July 6th.
First part moderate breezes. saw fin backs
and 800 fish. Latter part fresh breezes.
heading by to the S. Lat 2-28 Long 105-28

Remarks Monday July 7th.
First part fresh breezes from S.E. heading
by to the S. at 6 shortened sail. Latter part
fresh breezes. Course N. by W. saw fin backs.
Lat 5-08 Long 105-58

Remarks Tuesday July 8th.
First part fresh breezes from S.E. Course N. by W.
repaired the main top gall sail. Latter part
fresh breezes Course W. by S. Lat 4-40 Long 106-13
