tacked to the Westward. Latter
part fresh breeze from S. saw a whaling
boat heading to the Eastward.

S. heading by to the W. Latter part fresh

First part fresh breeze from S by E to

Remarks Sunday July 27th
Began with strong trades from S. E.
heading by to the S. W. Latter part strong
trades Lat 00-38 Long 113-47

Remarks Monday July 28th
First part fresh trades from S. E.
heading by to the S. W. Latter part moderate
from S. E. by E. Lat 00-26 Long 114-49

Remarks Tuesday July 29th
First part moderate breeze from S. E.
heading by to the S. W. Latter part
moderate. Lat 1-53 Long 115-32

Remarks Wednesday July 30th
First part moderate trades from
S. E. heading by to the S. Latter part
strong trades heading S by E. under
whale boat sails and courses.

Remarks Thursday July 31st 1879
First part strong trades from S. E. heading
by to the S. under top sails & courses. saw
a large launch. measured 28 feet long. 1 ft
beam. Copper bottom. must have come
from coast of Peru. she must have drifted
over two thousands of miles. Latter
part strong trades. Lat 4-54 Long 116-36

Remarks Friday August 1st
First part strong trades. heading by to the S.
at 5 P.M. raised a school of whales going quick
to the N. W. lowered the boats. but it was
too late. got nothing. Latter part strong trades.
at 9 P.M. raised a school of whales. ran into
them quite the ship. in the sun. it was very
bad seeing. lowered two boats at 11 3/4. the
L boat struck. then the W boat. lines got foul.
the 2d mate cut the mates line. and it came
quite a row. at noon lowered the other
two boats. Lat 5-05 Long 116-12

Remarks Saturday August 2nd
First part strong winds. at 2 P.M. we
took the W. B. whale along side. at 4 1/2
took the other along side. got dinner and
prepared for cutting. Latter strong trades and
breeze. at 6 P.M. commenced cutting. at noon
finished. Lat 4-29 Long 116-19

Remarks Sunday August 3rd
First part strong trades & rough sea.
at 3 P.M. commenced sailing. Latter part
strong trades. Lat 4-31 Long 116-15

Remarks Monday August 4th
First part strong trades and squally. at
9 P.M. finished sailing. Latter part
strong winds. Lat 5-03 Long 116-23.
