Lat 30-45 Long 128-27
Remarks Monday Oct 27th
First part wind N. by W. and rain. At
6 P. M. wind S. W. by N. South reef the top
sails. Spiked the main sail. Course E by S.
Middle part a little more moderate under single
reefs and bare and main top sail. Latter
part sand rain. No Ob.

Remarks Tuesday Oct 28th
First part fresh breezes from S. N. W. and
rain. Under single reefs. Bare & main top
gal sails. Course E by S. Middle part rainy.
Latter part moderate and clear. Course E.

Lat 32-41 Long 123-04
Remarks Wednesday Oct 29th
First part moderate breezes from W. N. W.
Course E. Latter part light air. Sent down
the bare top sail and repaired it.

Lat 32-55 Long 122-02
Remarks Thursday Oct 30th
First part moderate breezes from S. N. E. Course
E. another saw two P. B. We have three now
that have twelve between them. Latter fresh
breezes from S. N. W. and foggy.

Lat 33-17 Long 120-35
Remarks Friday Oct 31st
First part fresh breezes from the N. Course
E. all sail set. Saw 33 fish. Latter part
fresh breezes and clear.

Remarks Saturday Nov 1st 1879
First part fresh breezes from the N. Course
E. Latter part fresh breezes from N. by E.
Lat 34-37 Long 113-36

First part fresh breezes from N. by E. Course

Lat 35-33 Long 119-32
Remarks Monday Nov 3rd
Begins with strong winds from N. by E. at noon
took fore top gal sail. at 2 took in the main.
Latter part more moderate. Set top gal sails wind S. N. W.

Lat 36-56 Long 115-27
Remarks Tuesday Nov 4th
Begins with fresh breezes from S. W. but decreasing
Course E by N. Latter part the same wind S. W. by N.

Lat 37-17 Long 111-25-30
Remarks Wednesday Nov 5th
First part fresh breezes from S. W. Course
E by N. Middle part strong winds from W. N. W.
Latter calm and light air from S. W. with rain.

No Ob.
Remarks Thursday Nov 6th
Begins with light air from W. to S. N. W.
with rain. Middle and latter part light air from
S. W. to S. W. and calm and rain.

No Ob.
Remarks Friday Nov 7th
First part light air from W. N. W. to S. W. and
calm rain and bad weather. Latter part fresh
breezes from S. W. Course E by N. E. Saw a bark.
