Remarks Sunday Jan 18th 1880
First part fresh breezes from W & W. Spoke
the steamboat. Latter part moderate breezes
from S by E and fine weather. The best day we
have had since we have been here.

Lat 42-42 Long 75-41

Remarks Monday Jan 19th
Began with moderate breezes from S & W
and S W. Saw blump backs. Waiafo in
sight bearing S. S. E. Latter part moderate
breezes from the W & W and fog squalls.

Lat 42-49 Long 75-32

Remarks Tuesday Jan 20th
Began with moderate breezes from W & W
and thick fog. Latter part strong winds
from S & W. Four whales in sight.
Waiafo Dist 25 miles. Lat 43-11 Long 75-17

Remarks Wednesday Jan 21st
Began with strong winds from W & W by S.
Heading for the land at 2 P.M. More ship
off shore. Waiafo Dist 25 miles. Latter
part moderate. Saw 11 whales with our
sides. Lat 43-17 Long 75-40

Remarks Thursday Jan 22nd
Moderate breezes from W & W. Spoke
the L. & H. and the steamboat.
Land Dist 20 miles.

Remarks Friday Jan 23rd
Moderate breezes from W & W to W & N.
Spoke the L. & H. and the steamboat.
Latter part wind S by W and increasing.

Lat 44-14

Remarks Saturday Jan 24th
First part wind S and increasing.
Have too under close reefed main. Got sail
at 6 P.M. Bar 29.10. Blowing hard.
Wind S by W. This is the lowest bar
we have had since we have been here.

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We got - got - arrived Cape Horn. at 6 3/4
P.M. Under sail and have too on the port tack.
Blowing S. Bar continued to fall until 1 P.M. when
it stood at 29.10. Blowing heavy. Blowed away
the fore topmast after sail. at 1 1/2 the wind began
to haul slowly to the southward but no loss of it. at
3 P.M. wind S by W. Bar slowly rising. stood at
29.10 at 2 29.35. at 2 began to moderate. at
noon Bar 29.10. We were very fortunate to be
well off shore so we could have too on the port
tack. so as to take the advantage of the haul of
the wind.

Lat 43-48 Long 76-45

Remarks Saturday Jan 25th
Began with a gale from S & W and a heavy
sea. Bar 29.10. at 7 P.M. more moderate.
Bar 29.10. the L. & H. and the steamboat in sight.
Latter part fresh breezes from S & W. Steering in
for the land. at noon Bar 30.10

Lat 43-25 Long 76-16

Remarks Monday Jan 26th
Began with fresh breezes from S & W to W & N.
Saw 8 sails. Waiafo in sight Dist 35 miles.
Bar 30. Latter part a gale from S & W. Under close
reefs. Bar 29.10

Lat 43-00 Long 75-55

Remarks Tuesday Jan 27th
Began with a gale from the S & W under close
reefs. at 7 P.M. took in the fore top sail.
Latter part strong winds from W & W. and thick
weather. Bar 29.10

Lat 42-29 No Cal

Remarks Wednesday Jan 28th
Began with strong winds from W & W and
thick weather. Under close reefed main and
close reefed fore top sail. at 5 1/2 P.M. put
away fore the main. We are too far to cruise here
and wait for whales and weather. Latter part
fresh breezes and rain under close reefs.
