Remarks Tuesday March 2nd 1880
First part strong winds from S. & E.
Course S. & E. at 6 1/2 kts. In fore ship off
shore. The high land of St. Mary's
Dist 30 miles. Close reefed. Latter
part strong winds. Under close reef.
Lat 37-18 Long 73-16

Remarks Wednesday March 3rd
First part strong winds from S. & E.
Under reefed. Under close reef.
Latter part more moderate. Saw a
merchant bark.
Lat 36-51 Long 73-30

Remarks Thursday March 4th
First part moderate breeze from W. & S.
Latter part strong winds from S. & E. Under
Double reef. Prepared the fore sail.
Lat 36-36 Long 73-55

Remarks Friday March 5th
First part strong winds from S. & E.
Under close reef. Latter part strong
winds. Under close reef. Saw the John
& Winthrop.
Lat 36-40 Long 73-57

Remarks Saturday March 6th
First part strong winds from S. & E.
Under close reef. Latter part more moderate.
Lat 36-38 Long 73-43

Remarks Sunday March 7th
First part fresh breezes from S.
Under Double reef. Latter part strong
winds from S. Under Double reef.
Lat 36-41 Long 73-10

Dark Mary & Susan off St. Mary's

Remarks Monday March 8th 1880
First part strong winds from S. Under Double
reef. Saw a dead Bull back or Sulphur
Wharton well bleached. Latter part a gale
from the S. & E. Have to head to the Eastward.
Under a close reef main top sail and stay sails.
Lat 36-53 Long 74-48

Remarks Tuesday March 9th
Begins with a strong gale from S. by E. Have
to head to the Eastward under a close reef main
top sail & stay sails. At 5 1/2 kts. In fore ship to
the Westward. Bar 29.70. St. Mary's Dist 40 miles.
Latter part the same but a little more moderate.
Lat 36-39 Long 73-06

Remarks Wednesday March 10th
Begins with strong winds from S. Under
close reef. Heading W. & S. At 5 1/2 kts. In fore ship to
the Eastward. Latter part fresh
breezes from S. & W. Heading to the
Eastward.
Lat 36-37 Long 73-45

Remarks Thursday March 11th
Begins with moderate breeze from
S. W. Steering for Calcuttuan. At
5 kts. passed Quiriquina and then
the wine died away. At 9 kts. Came
to anchor down the bar.

Remarks Friday March 12th
Calm. At 8 A.M. took the anchor, and
proceed on with the boat and towed
to the Anchorage. At 10 kts. anchored in 6 faths
of water.
