Sept 2nd

Sunday September 2nd
This day begins with light winds from
SE on the port tack at noon 000
Range of sperm whales at 2 00
lowered three Boats & B struck one and
drove from him at sun down Boats
began on board middle parts during
SB at day light and latter parts the same
SB 6 Lat 33° 31' N Lon 42° 11' W

Monday 3rd
This day begins with pleasant breeze from
SE at 7:30 000 Range of sperm whales lowered three Boats
struck and got one got him long side at
sun down more whales in sight middle
parts fine weather at day light got ready and
began on the whale moderate wind from SE & B
on the port tack Lat 33° 20' N Lon 42° 20' W

Tuesday 4th
This day begins with pleasant breeze from SE
on the port tack started by work and break
out for dried Apple and tea Molasses and
flour at sun down watch employed in
boiling middle parts got trees and turn
up 6 Bills at day light and latter parts fine
weather continued Lat 32° 20' N Lon 41° 14' W

Wednesday 5th
This day begins with light winds from
SE and force on the port tack at
sun down on the starboard tack middle
parts the same at day light and latter parts
fine weather watch employed in the ship
duties Lat 33° 14' N Lon 41° 20' W

Friday Sept 14th
This day begins with strong winds from
SW on the starboard tack employed
in the ship duties at sun down on
the starboard tack middle parts the
same at day light and latter parts
fine weather saw two sails passed
steamer John Deverson & Co. Casell
steamer at 11 Lat 34° 57' N Lon 34° 18' W

Saturday 15th
This day begins with moderate winds
from SE on the starboard tack
watch employed in the ship duties
at sun down took in sails
on the starboard tack middle parts
Cabin at day light the same two sails
in sight at eight 000 Range
separate of sperm whales at 1030 lowered
three Boats struck latter parts
Boats off

Sunday 16th
This day begins with light winds Boats
down and fast at two 000 took
one long side at three took took
no other long side and commenced
boiling in at eight 000 got
three in and seat the watch middle
parts fine weather at day light and
latter parts strong winds from SW
in the starboard tack employed in
boiling Lat 34° 59' N Lon 33° 36'

Monday 17th
This day begins with strong winds from
SW on the starboard tack at sun
down took in fore top sail employed
in boiling middle parts equally
and during at day light and latter
parts the same got new boiling turn
up 26 Bills Lat 34° 31' N Lon
