Tuesday November 20th 1844

This day begins with pleasant breeze from
S steering S.W. & one sail in sight
watch employed in the ship's duty
at sun down the same continued
middle part the same at day light and
latter part strong wind from N.E.
steering S.W. watch employed in the ship's
duty Lat 31.35 S Lon 42.54 W

Wednesday 21st

This day begins with strong winds from N.E.
steering S.W. watch employed in the ship's
duty at sun down the same continued
middle part strong wind at day light and
latter part the same watch employed in
the ship's duty Lat 33.50 S Lon 45.15 W

Thursday 22nd

This day begins with strong winds from
N.E. steering S.W. watch employed
in the ship's duty at sun down strong
wind continued middle part strong
gale from N.E. steering S.W. at day
light the same

Friday 23rd

This day begins with strong gale from N.E.
steering S.W. at two o'clock it would let go
and it came from S.W. veering to the
S over her to on the port tack under
blow reefed main top sail and stay
sail at sun down strong gale from
S continued at ten o'clock bared up
the truss on main top sail yard middle
part moderated at four top sail at day
light and latter part moderated employed
in referring the truss on the main top
sail yard Lat 36.14 S Lon 48

Wednesday October 31st

This day begins with light and variable wind
sun five sails at sun down light wind
from N.E. steering S by E middle
part variable winds at day light and
latter part light winds from S.E. on the
port tack 15 sail in sight watch employed
in the ship's duty Lat 04.20 N Lon 26.04 W

Thursday November 1st

This day begins with moderate winds
from S on the port tack several
sail in sight watch employed in the
ship's duty at sun down pleasant breeze
from S continued middle part
equally weather at day light and latter part
the same watch employed in the ship's duty
Lat 03.49 N

Friday 2nd

This day begins with strong breeze from
S on the port tack watch employed in
the ship's duty at sun down moderate winds
continued middle part the same at
day light and latter part one sail in sight
watch employed in the ship's duty
Lat 04.25 N Lon 28.01 W

Saturday 3rd

This day begins with strong winds from
S.E. & on the port tack two sails in
sight watch employed in the ship's
duty at sun down strong breeze
continued middle part strong breeze
at day light and latter part the same
two sail in sight watch employed in
the ship's duty Lat 00.52 S
Lon 28.56 W
