

Journal of Bark Mary & Susan 1878
Saturday January 5th 1878

This day begins with strong winds from E.N.W. on the starboard tack at sun down Bark under Closest Reefed top sails middle parts moderate at daylight Rainy weather Continued at ten A.M. where ship on the port tack wind from N.W. latter part Strong wind Continued
Lat 44.74 S Lon 78.30 W

Sunday 6th

This day begins with strong breeze from N.W. on the starboard tack at sun down took in sail on the starboard tack middle parts the same at three A.M. wind hauled from E.W. where ship on the starboard tack at ten A.M. wind hauled from W steering E
Lat 45.09 S Lon 77.32 W

Monday 7th

This day begins with strong breeze from N.W. steering E at sun down under Closest reefed top sails middle parts the same at day light more moderate watch employed in the ships duty latter part pleasant breeze from S.W. steering E 1/2 W Lat 45.48 S Lon 76.32 W

Tuesday 8th

This day begins with pleasant breeze from S.W. steering E 1/2 W at sun down took in sails hove her to on the port tack middle parts the same at day light made sails steering W 1/2 N with pleasant breeze from S.W. latter part the same Lat 39.55 S Lon 75.32 W

Journal Continued
Friday January 18th 1878

This day begins with light air and calm watch employed in the ships duty at sun down took in sails Calm Continued at ten P.M. moderate wind from E.W. at day light strong wind from E on the starboard tack thick and Rainy weather latter part pleasant weather on the starboard tack Lat 39.03 S Lon 76.35 W

Saturday 19th

This day begins with pleasant breeze from W on the starboard tack at sun down took in sail on the starboard tack middle parts the same at day light and latter part hazy weather watch employed in the ships duty Lat 39.17 S Lon 76.06 W

Sunday 20th

This day begins with pleasant breeze from S on the port tack Sun one sail at sun down took in sails on the port tack middle parts the same at daylight and latter part strong breeze from S.E. Continued Lat 39.47 S Lon 77.14 W

Monday 21st

This day begins with strong breeze from S.E. on the starboard tack sun several fimbarks at sun down took in sail on the starboard tack middle parts the same at day light and latter part strong breeze from S.E. Continued watch employed in ships duty Lat 39.43 S Lon 75.50 W

Tuesday 22

This day begins with strong winds from S.E. on the starboard tack watch employed in the ships duty at sun down took in sails on the port tack land on sight to Eastward middle parts fine weather at day light the same at eight A.M. kept her way N watch employed in the ships duty Lat 39.21 S Lon 75.15 W
