

Journal of the voyage on board Bark Mary & Susan 1847

Saturday February 22

This day begins with light winds from S. Bark on the starboard tack at sun dawn we are ship on the port tack middle part. Calm at day light and latter part the same employed in Repairing the Boat.

Sunday 23rd

This day begins with Calm at four o'clock got tree with the Boat and put her out at sun dawn Calm continued middle part the same at day light Calm latter part moderate breeze from N.W. Steering S. Lat 42 39 S Lon 75 10 W

Monday 24th

This day begins with moderate winds from N.W. Steering S. at two o'clock squally and raining sighted the land and we are ship on the starboard tack at three o'clock wind hauled from S.W. we are ship on the port tack at sun dawn took in Sails Bark on the port tack middle part the same at day light and latter part strong winds from S. Bark on the starboard tack watch employed in Ships duty Lat 42 43 S Lon 75 45 W

Tuesday 25th

This day begins with strong breeze from S. Bark on the port tack at sun dawn took in Sails Bark on the port tack middle part the same at day light Calm latter part pleasant wind from N.W. Steering S. Lat 42 40 S Lon 75 40 W

Wednesday 26th

This day begins with pleasant breeze from N.W. Steering S. at three o'clock we are ship on the starboard tack at sun dawn under about reefed main top sail and stay sail strong gale from N.W. middle part wind hauled from S.W. Bark on the starboard tack at day light and latter part strong winds from N. Bark on the starboard tack watch employed in the Ships duty Lat 42 48 S Lon 75 56 W

Wednesday March 5th

This day begins with light winds from N.W. Steering S. at sun dawn took in Sails Bark on the port tack Calm middle part the same at day light and latter part moderate winds from N.W. Bark on the starboard tack one sail in sight Lat 41 58 S Lon 75 28 W

Thursday March 6th

This day begins with moderate breeze from N. Bark on the starboard tack spack Bark Bark Hamboul at sun dawn took in Sails Bark on the starboard tack middle part light wind at day light Calm latter part light wind from S. Bark on the starboard tack one sail in sight Lat 42 17 S Lon 75 10 W

Friday 7th

This day begins with light winds from S. Bark on the starboard tack one sail in sight at sun dawn took in Sails Bark on the port tack middle part light wind from S. we are ship on the starboard tack at day light Steering S. one sail in sight watch employed in the Ships duty Lat 42 21 S Lon 75 58 W

Saturday 8th

This day begins with pleasant breeze from S. Bark Steering S. Son Island of Chiloe bearing S 25 miles of passed a steamer bound S. at sun dawn took in Sails one sail in sight middle part Calm at day light and latter part light air from S. and Calm one sail in sight Lat 42 29 S Lon 75 05 W

Sunday 9th

This day begins with light air from S. and one sail in sight at sun dawn the same Bark on the port tack middle part the same at day light and latter part light wind from S. Bark on the starboard tack land in sight Lat 42 02 S Lon 75 15 W
