

Journal of the Voyage On Board Bark *Mary & Susan* 1849⁹

Monday March 10th
This day begins with light airs and Calm at sun-
down Calm continued middle part breeze from
N.W. Bark on the starboard tack at day light and latter
part strong winds from E and hazy weather
Lat 42° 15'

Tuesday 11th
This day begins with strong winds from N.W. Bark
on the starboard tack at two P.M. wind hauls
from W at sun down Rainy weather Bark on
the port tack middle part Calm at day light and
latter part the same watch employed in the Ship
deuty Lat 42° 02' S Lon 75° 50' W

Wednesday 12th
This day begins with Calm at sun down the
same tack in Sails Bark on the starboard
tack middle part light winds from N at day
light and latter part moderate winds from
N.W. Steering S.E. saw two Sails watch
employed in Ship's duty Lat 42° 32' S Lon 75° 4'

Thursday 13th
This day begins with pleasant breeze from N.W.
steering S.E. at 5:30 P.M. Raze two Sperm whale
going quick to N.W. lowered lower boats
but it came on dark before they came up
again Boats come on board bark in sails
Bark on the starboard tack middle part Calm
at day light and latter part the same Lat 42° 34' S Lon 75° 17'

Friday 14th
This day begins with Calm at sun down light airs
from S.W. Bark on the port tack took in Sails
middle part thick fog Bark on the starboard tack
at day light the same latter part cleared up light
winds from S.W. Lat 42° 36' S Lon 75° 15' W

Tuesday March 25th
This day begins with strong breeze from W. Bark
on the starboard tack at sun down took in
sails Bark on the port tack middle part the same
at day light and latter part strong winds from S.W.
steering S.W. at 11 A.M. saw the Island of Hovafu
bearing E. 83° miles off Lat 43° 35' S Lon 75° 15' W

Wednesday 26th
This day begins with strong breeze from S.W.
Bark steering E at 8 P.M. Island of Hovafu
bearing E 14 miles off in care ship steering
N.W. at sun down pleasant breeze from
S.W. Bark steering N.W. middle part moderate
weather at day light and latter part the same the
Island of Chiloe in sight Lat 42° 25' S Lon 75° 15' W

Thursday 27th
This day begins with pleasant breeze from S.W. Bark
steering N.W. land in sight at sun down
light winds from W middle part the same at day
light and latter part light air from N.W. Bark on the
starboard tack land in sight Lat 41° 51' S Lon 75° 24' W

Friday 28th
This day begins with light air from N.E. Bark on
the starboard tack at sun down the same middle
part moderate winds from S.E. steering N.W. at
day light and latter part strong breeze continued
watch employed in the Ship's duty Lat 41° 14' S Lon 75° 50' W

Saturday 29th
This day begins with strong winds from S.E. steering
N.E. at three P.M. kept her N at sun
down strong winds from S.E. steering N
middle part the same at day light pleasant breeze
steering N. by E. latter part the same one sail
in sight Lat 38° 01' S Lon 75° 08' W
