

Journal of Bark Mary & Sailed November 1879

Thursday 13th
This day begins with light winds from S.W. steering
by N $\frac{1}{2}$ E at sun down the same continued
middle part calm at day light and latter part
light air from S.W. steering by E $\frac{1}{2}$ S Lat 37.06 S Lon 81.50 W

Friday 14th
This day begins with light winds from S.W. steering
by N $\frac{1}{2}$ E at sun down the same continued middle part
moderate winds at day light and latter part the same
one sail in sight Lat 37.08 S Lon 80.15 W

Saturday 15th
This day begins with moderate winds from S.W. steering
by N $\frac{1}{2}$ E at sun down pleasant breeze from S
continued middle part the same at day light and latter
part pleasant breeze Lat 36.52 S Lon 78.50 W

Sunday 16th
This day begins with pleasant breeze from S.W. steering
by N $\frac{1}{2}$ E at sun down the same continued
middle part the same at day light and latter part light
wind one sail in sight Lat 36.42 S Lon 74.50 W

Monday 17th
This day begins with light winds from S.W. steering
by E $\frac{1}{2}$ S at sun down land in sight
middle part light winds at day light moderate winds
from E latter part came to Anchor $\frac{1}{2}$ mile S of
Cape Quena in 11 fathoms of water

Tuesday 18th
This day began to an Anchor Boat went shore with
Beltono Gonzalez and Charles M. West. Sick and
discharge them sent fore sail and main the gale
sail to Reppare at sun down put the
middle part strong winds from E at day light more
moderate latter part fine weather employed in repairing
fore sail and main the gale sail

Wednesday 19th
This day begins with fine weather at four o'clock sent
fore sail and main gale sail middle part fine
weather at day light and latter part the same Repair
steer sail and sent at John Lupton got humbug
and head to be put in iron

Thursday 20th
This day begins with fine weather wind from N. at
sun down the same continued middle part Rainy
at day light and latter part the same

Friday 21st
This day begins with moderate winds from N at
sun down strong winds and Rainy weather
middle part the same at day light and latter
part light and variable winds took John Lupton
out of iron

Saturday 22nd
This day begins with light winds from S at three
P.M. got under way at sun down strong winds from
S.W. by the wind on the port tack middle part the
same at day light and latter part strong winds from
S on the port tack Lat 36.36 S Lon 75.29 W

Sunday 23rd
This day begins with strong winds from S Bark
on the port tack at sun down pleasant winds
from S middle part light and variable winds at day
light and latter part moderate winds from S.W.
Bark on the port tack Lat 36.14 S Lon 76.39 W

Monday 24th
This day begins with pleasant breeze from S.W.
Bark on the port tack at sun down the same
middle part the same at day light and latter part the
same one sail in sight Lat 35.48 S Lon 78.50 W

Tuesday 25th
This day begins with strong winds from S.W. Bark on
the starboard tack at sun down on the port tack middle
part the same at day light and latter part strong
winds from S Lat 36.07 S Lon 79.20 W
