Wednesday November 26th

This day begins with strong winds from S. Bark on the port tack at sun down the same continued middle part the same at 100 & 40 near ship on the starboard tack at day light and latter part the same saw a school of black fish

Thursday 27th

This day begins with pleasant breeze from S.W. Bark on the starboard tack at sun down the same middle part the same at day light and latter part the same hazy weather
Lat 38.10 S Lon 78.43 W

Friday 28th

This day begins with pleasant breeze from S.W. Bark on the port tack one sail in sight at sun down the same continued middle part calm at one 100. near ship on the starboard tack at day light and latter part moderate winds from W. Bark on the starboard tack

Saturday 29th

This day begins with strong breeze from W. Bark on the starboard tack at sun down strong winds from W. continued middle part the same at day light hazy weather at 6 A.M. raised school of sperm whales. lowered boat struck five and got three bow boat got stove saw two sails

Sunday 30th

This day begins with strong winds from W. employed in cutting in at sun down got two seals in and put two flux chains on the one long side braced forward on the starboard tack middle part strong winds at day light commenced to butt in rime & got true butman employed in clearing way head
Lat 40.23 S Lon 79.38 W

Monday December 1st

This day begins with strong winds from W. started trip worked at sundown employed in boiling middle part the same at day light and latter part. Calm employed in boiling
Lat 40.10 S Lon 79.44 W

Tuesday 2nd

This day begins with light wind from W. Bark on the starboard tack employed in boiling middle part the same at day light got three ballin turn up 62 S.B. latter part strong wind from W. steering S.W. by S

Wednesday 3rd

This day begins with strong winds from W. steering S.W. by S at sun down strong winds continued middle part the same at day light and latter part strong winds from W. steering S.W. employed in storing down oil latter part got three ston 55 S.B. Lat 42.22 S Lon 81.52 W

Thursday 4th

This day begins with strong breeze from W. bark thick and raining weather at sun down the same continued steering S. middle part strong gale bark on the port tack at day light near ship on the starboard tack latter part the same continued Lat 46.12 S Lon 81.52

Friday 5th

This day begins with strong gale from W. Bark on the starboard tack at sun down the same continued middle part strong gale at day light and latter part more moderate
Lat 44.02 S Lon 81.21 W

Saturday 6th

This day begins with strong winds from W. Bark on the starboard tack saw school of black fish at sun down strong winds continued middle part moderated at day light and latter part light wind from E. Bark steering S. took in the bow boat to repair
