

Journal of Bark Mary & Susan January 1880

Thursday 29th

This day begins with strong winds from S.W. steering N.W. at sun down moderate middle part of the ship at day light and latter part the same one sail on sight employed in the ship's duty Lat 39.29 S Lon 75.25 W

Friday 30th

This day begins with light winds from S.W. steering N.W. at sun down light winds middle part of the ship at day light fine weather Island of Malak in sight bearing E. sent down fore top sail to repair Lat 38.30 S Lon 74.38 W

Saturday 31st

This day begins with light wind from S. steering N.W. Malak in sight employed in repairing fore top sail at sun down steering N.W. middle part light winds and hazy weather at day light the same son's steamer bound S employed in repairing and sent fore top sail land in sight Lat 37.28 S Lon 74.17 W

Sunday February 1st

This day begins with pleasant winds from S. steering N.W. at sun down took in sails on the port tack middle part the same at day light and latter part strong winds steering N.W. Lat 36.46 S Lon 76.11 W

Monday 2nd

This day begins with strong winds from S.E. steering N.W. at sun down the same middle part the same at day light and latter part moderated Lat 34.57 S Lon 77.42 W

Tuesday 3rd

This day begins with pleasant breeze from S. steering N.W. son one sent at sun down took in sails moderate winds from S.W. bark on the port tack middle part light winds at day light and latter part the same Lat 34.14 S Lon 78.36 W

Wednesday 4th

This day begins with light winds from S.W. bark on the port tack at sun down Island of Juan Hernandez in sight took in sails bark on the port tack middle part the same at day light and latter part fine weather sent down main top sail and repair it land in sight Lat 33.37 S

Thursday February 5th

This day begins with moderate winds from S.W. bark on the starboard tack employed in repairing main top sail at sun down sent it took in sails on the starboard tack middle part the same bark on the port tack at day light and latter part strong winds from S. land about five miles off

Friday 6th

This day begins with strong winds from S. bark running by the land at sun down took in sails on the port tack land about 8 miles off middle part fine weather at day light the same land in sight wind S.W. sent in jib and repair it Lat 35.12 S Lon 79.21 W

Saturday 7th

This day begins with pleasant breeze from S.W. bark on the port tack at sun down took in sails on the starboard tack middle part the same at day light and latter part fine wind from S. bark on the starboard tack Lat 33.10 S Lon 79.00

Sunday 8th

This day begins with moderate winds from S. bark on the starboard tack land in sight at sun down took in sails bark on the port tack middle part on the port tack at day light and latter part in the starboard tack Juan Hernandez in sight Lat 33.29 S Lon 79.07 W

Monday 9th

This day begins with moderate winds from S. land about five miles off at sun down took in sails bark on the port tack middle part the same at day light and latter part pleasant winds from S.W. bark on the starboard tack land in sight one sail in sight Lat 33.35 S Lon 79.13 W

Tuesday 10th

This day begins with pleasant winds from S.W. bark on the starboard tack at sun down took in sails at nine P.M. wind hauled from S. wear ship on the port tack middle part strong winds at day light and latter part the same son bark John & Wythrop to Juan Hernandez in sight Lat 33.57 S Lon 79.21 W
