Thursday March 11th
This day begins with strong winds from S. Back.
stirring. Bled at 1 P.M. made the land at 5 P.M.
passed the Karaguina Island at night
at 12 m. calm lowered Boats and tow in at 12 m. came
to Anchor at day light got under way light wind
from N and Starboard in at noon came to Anchor
in 6 f. the water

Friday 12th
This day begins with fine weather middle and latter
part the same employed in the ships duties

Saturday 13th
This day begins with fine weather employed in the
ships duties middle and latter part the same

Sunday 14th
This day begins with fine weather middle and
latter part the same sent watch ashore on the liberty

Monday 15th
This day begins with fine weather middle part the
same at day light watch Return on board light
winds from N employed in the ships duties

Tuesday 16th
This day begins with
fine weather at sun down the same middle and
latter part the same

Wednesday 17th
This day begins with strong winds from N. Windy
and latter part the same

Thursday 18th
This day begins with strong winds from N. middle
and latter part the same

Friday 19th
This day begins with moderate winds from N
at sun down winds middle and latter part of the same

Saturday 20th
This day begins with strong winds from
N middle and latter part the same

Sunday 21st
This day begins with moderate winds from N
at sun down fine weather middle and latter
part the same at day light and latter part the same

Monday 22nd
This day begins with fine weather got 96 Bbls oil on
board A. J. Brown middle and latter part the
fine weather

Tuesday 23rd
This day begins with pleasant weather at sun down
the same middle and latter part the same

Wednesday 24th
This day begins with fine weather at sun down the
same middle and latter part the same

Thursday 25th
This day begins with fine weather employed in
the ships duties at sun down and latter part the same

Friday 26th
This day begins with fine weather at sun down and
latter part the same landed 4 Bbls Shuck

Saturday 27th
This day begins with fine weather at sun down the
same middle and latter part the same

Sunday 28th
This day begins with fine weather at sun down
the same at day light sent watch ashore on
liberty

Monday 29th
This day begins with fine weather at sun down the
same middle part the same at day light watch
came on board Joseph Gaspar. Departed latter
part fine weather employed in the ships duties
