Friday June 25th

This day begins with strong trades back on the port tack at Sun down took in sail back on the port tack at daylight and latter parte on the starboard tack watch employed in the Ship's duties Lat 05:24 S Lon 105:39 W

Saturday 26th

This day begins with strong trades back on the starboard tack at Sun down took in Sails the same Continued middle parte the same at day light and latter parte moderate trades back on the port tack Lat 05:57 S Lon 105:57 W

Sunday 27th

This day begins with moderate trades back on the port tack at Sun down took in Sails the same Continued middle parte the same at day light and latter parte on the starboard tack Lat 04:45 S Lon 105:58 W

Monday 28th

This day begins with strong trades back on the starboard tack at Sun down took in Sails middle parte were ship on the port tack at day light steering S by W at nine A.M. large school of sperm whales goin to windward made sail and give chase at noon whale three mile off Lat 04:38 S Lon 106:14 W

Tuesday 29th

This day begins with strong trades chasing the whales at 2:30 P.M. they went out sight to windward at Sun down took in Sails middle parte strong trades at 2 A.M. were ship on the port tack at day light and latter parte strong trades Continued San a promppter Lat 04:38 S Lon 106:34 W

Wednesday 30th

This day begins with strong trades on the port tack at Sun down took in Sails on the starboard tack middle parte the same at day light and latter parte strong winds from S.E. and squally weather Lat 04:34 S Lon 106:24 W

Thursday July 1st 1880

This day begins with strong trades back on the starboard tack at Sun down took in Sails middle parte the same at day light and latter parte the same watch employed in the Ship's duties Lat 04:08 S Lon 105:55 W

Friday 2nd

This day begins with strong trades back on the port tack at Sun down took in Sails middle parte were ship on the starboard tack at day light and latter parte pleasant trades San black fish Lat 04:49 S Lon 106:23 W

Saturday 3rd

This day begins with pleasant trades back on the starboard tack at Sun down took in Sails middle parte the same at day light were on the port tack on sail in sight at nine A.M. large school of whales goin to windward give chase Lat 04:29 S Lon 106:05 W

Sunday 4th

This day begins with strong trades at one P.M. lowered three boats and chase the whales to windward did get near them at Sun down boats born on board took in light Sails on the starboard tack middle parte were ship on the port tack at day light and latter parte the same Lat 04:49 S Lon 106:04 W

Monday 5th

This day begins with strong trades on the starboard tack at Sun one Seal in sight middle parte the same at day light and latter parte on the port tack Lat 04:41 S Lon 105:45 W

Tuesday 6th

This day begins with strong trades back on the port tack at Sun down took in the starboard tack middle parte the same at day light and latter parte on the port tack watch employed in the Ship's duties Lat 04:51 S Lon 105:44 W
