

Bark Mary & Susan Journal August 1880

Tuesday 17th

This day begins with pleasant trades bark on the starboard tack at sundown the same middle part the same at day light and latter part pleasant trades watch employed in the ships duty Lat 1.09 N Lon 100.06 W

Wednesday 18th

This day begins with pleasant trades bark on the starboard tack at sundown the same middle part moderate trades at day light and latter part the same Lat 02.01 N Lon 99.14 W

Thursday 19th

This day begins with pleasant trades bark on the starboard tack at sundown the same continued middle and latter part the same watch employed in the ships duty Lat 02.31 N Lon 97.54 W

Friday 20th

This day begins with strong trades bark on the starboard tack at sundown the same middle part the same at day light and latter part strong trades continued

Saturday 21st

This day begins with strong trades bark on the starboard tack at sundown the same middle part moderate at day light and latter part fine weather Lat 02.26 N Lon 94.41 W

Sunday 22nd

This day begins with moderate winds from S bark on the starboard tack at sundown the same middle and latter part the same Lat 02.18 N Lon 93.19 W

Monday 23rd

This day begins with pleasant trades bark on the starboard tack at sundown the same middle part pleasant trades at day light and latter part strong trades watch employed in the ships duty

Tuesday August 24th

This day begins with strong trades on the starboard tack at sundown the same continued middle part the same at day light Callapea and Oppimen Islands in sight range. School of sperm whales lowered boats struck and found the Chre to be 75 miles out

Wednesday 25th

This day begins with pleasant trades boats down after whales at three o'clock took the whale long side and cutt him in at sundown got tree took in light sails on the starboard tack middle part on the port tack at day light hazy weather at nine A.M. were ship on the starboard tack started tree works latter part pleasant trades Callapea in sight Lat 02.4 N Lon

Thursday 26th

This day begins with pleasant trades at sundown the same employed in balling at ten o'clock got tree turn up 23 bells bark on the starboard tack at day light and latter part the same Albamar Island in sight Lat 00.38 N

Friday 27th

This day begins with pleasant trades bark on the starboard tack at four o'clock passed the Redondo Rock on sail in sight at sundown the same continued bark on the port tack middle part on the starboard tack at day light and latter part three sail in sight Lat 00.05 N Lon 91

Saturday 28th

This day begins with pleasant breeze from S. cutting off sea bar employed in stowing down sail at sundown land about 15 miles off middle part off and on at day light and latter part Clabrough Island ten to 15 miles

Sunday 29th

This day begins with pleasant trades two sails in sight spack Yahn P. west at sundown pleasant trades middle part the same at day light and latter part pleasant breeze off North ahead Gallapagos Island two sails in sight
