

Journal of Bark Mary & Susan Sept 1880

Monday 13th

This day begins with strong breeze one sail in sight off the head at sundown the same middle and leather parts pleasant trades off Nabrough with employed under ships duty's one sail in sight

Tuesday 14th

This day begins with pleasant trades one sail in sight at sun down the same middle and leather parts pleasant breeze one sail in sight

Wednesday 15th

This day begins with pleasant trades Bark on the port tack off Island of Nabrough one sail in sight at sun down the same middle parts fine weather at day light and leather parts one sail in sight Nabrough about ten miles off

Thursday 16th

This day begins with light breeze steering N one sail in sight at sun down N. off about 4 miles to N. should to the wind one the port tack middle parts calm at day light and leather parts light steering N

Friday 17th

This day begins with moderate winds steering N. Bark on the port tack at sun down hauled to the wind on the port tack middle parts the same at day light and leather parts the same two sail in sight

Saturday 18th

This day begins with light winds at two P.M. two Boats went ashore fishing at sun down Boats Return with with fish and 17 green. Turtle light winds from N. standing off shore middle parts calm at day light and leather parts the same two sail in sight

Sunday 19th

This day begins with light winds from S Bark on port tack at sun down the same middle and leather parts light air one sail in sight

Journal Continued

Monday Sept 20th

This day begins with light winds from S on the starboard tack at two P.M. kept her way S. & E. one sail then the S at sun down the same middle parts the same at day light off Abington Island ten miles off and John & West in sight at ten two Boats from each ship went fishing

Tuesday 21st

This day begins with light winds two Boats in fishing at sun down Return on board steering N. by N. middle parts calm at day light and leather parts heavy weather and moderate trades Bark on starboard tack

Wednesday 22nd

This day begins with pleasant trades on the starboard tack off Cape John & West at sun down the same middle and leather parts the same latitude
Lat 21 12 N Long 20 11 W

Thursday 23rd

This day begins with pleasant breeze Bark on the starboard tack at sun down the same one sail in sight middle parts the same at day light and leather parts pleasant trades

Friday 24th

This day begins with pleasant trades on the starboard tack one sail in sight at sun down took in sails on starboard tack middle parts the same at day light and leather parts strong trades
Lat 20 35 N Long 19 12 W

Saturday 25th

This day begins with strong trades Bark on the starboard tack one sail in sight at sun down took in sails strong trades Continued middle and leather parts the same
Lat 20 18 N Long 18 02 W

Sunday 26th

This day begins with strong trades Bark under double reef top sails on the starboard tack at sun down the same middle parts the same at day light and leather parts more moderate at ten P.M. Raise sperm whales gone to windward lowered Boats struck 2 P.M. Lost one John & West did not get away
