

Journal of The Voyage On Board *Sh. Mary & Susan* 1880
Monday Sept 27th

This day begins with moderate winds and squally
Boats down with whale at fore & M. Boat return on
Board commenced to cut the whale at sun down
got tree bark on the starboard tack middle part
on the port tack at day and latter part the same at ten
A.M. started three weeks one sail in sight Lat 00 31 N
Lon 88 31 W

Tuesday 28th
This day begins with moderate winds on the starboard
tack one sail in sight employed in boiling
at 8 P.M. got tree turn up to B.B. on the port
tack middle part pleasant breeze at day light and latter
part the same one sail in sight Lat 00 28 N Lon 88 14 W

Wednesday 29th
This day begins with pleasant trades bark on the
starboard tack one sail in sight at sun down
the same continued middle part the same at day
light and latter part hazy weather Lat 00 04 S Lon 88 37 W

Thursday 30th
This day begins with pleasant trades on the starboard tack
one sail in sight at sun down the same continued
middle part the same at day light and latter part
the same hazy weather Lat 00 55 S Lon 88 40 W

Friday October 1st
This day begins with strong trades bark on the starboard
tack one sail in sight at sun down the same
continued middle part moderate at day light and
latter part the same Lat 00 00 S Lon 88 29 W

Saturday 2d
This day begins with moderate winds on the starboard
tack one sail in sight at sun down on the port
tack middle part the same at day light and latter
part hazy weather Lat 02 10 S Lon 88 50 W

Mary & Susan's Journal Continued

Sunday October 3rd
This day begins with pleasant trades bark on the port
tack at sun down the same continued middle part
the same at day light and latter part light trades down
fore back Lat 02 10 S Lon 88 01 W

Monday 4th
This day begins with light winds and hazy weather
Bark on the port tack at sun down the same
middle part the same at day light and latter part calm
employed in repairing fore top sail Lat 02 06 S Lon 88 56

Tuesday 5th
This day begins with light air bark on the port tack
at sun down the same middle part light winds at
day light and latter part the same Lat 02 21 S Lon 87 04 W

Wednesday 6th
This day begins with pleasant trades bark on the port
tack at 5 P.M. Raze whale five miles off
at dark whale boat mile off middle part the
same at day light the same at nine A.M. Raze a
large whale lowered boats B.B. drove them up
Lat 02 24 S Lon 88 05 W

Thursday 7th
This day begins with fine weather boats down chasing
the whale at sun down return on board on the
starboard tack middle part leaping back at day
light and latter part light air steering over to
Raze whale to M.B. 6 miles off Lat 02 49 S Lon 88 02

Friday 8th
This day begins with light air at 1 P.M. lowered three
boats for whale going quick did not get any
at sun down return on board bark on
the port tack middle part the same at day light and
latter part light air Lat 02 51 S Lon 88 26 W

Saturday 9th
This day begins with light winds steering at sun
down on the starboard tack middle part calm
at day light and latter part light air Lat 02 51 S
Lon 88 17 W
