Wednesday 17th
This day begins with fine weather employed in clearing dry head at sundown got tree at 2 PM started try wreck Bark on the port tack middle and latter parts employed in brilling Lat 05 22 Lon 83 00

Thursday 18th
This day begins with pleasant trades on the port tack employed in brilling at Sundown the same continued middle and latter parts the same

Friday 19th
This day begins with fine weather employed in brilling at Sundown the same middle parts the same at day light got tree brilling turn up 150 lbs latter parts employed in the ship's duty Lat 06 38 Lon 85 21 W

Saturday 20th
This day begins with pleasant trades Bark on the port tack at Sundown the same continued middle parts the same at day light and latter parts pleasant weather employed in stowing down oil in main hole Lat 07 59 Lon 86 40 W

Sunday 21st
This day begins with pleasant breeze from Son on the port tack employed in stowing down at Sundown fine weather continued middle and latter parts the same Lat 07 57 Lon 86 40 W

Monday 22nd
This day begins with pleasant trades Bark on the port tack at Sundown the same middle parts pleasant breeze at day light the same employed in stowing down two sails in sight latter parts got tree stowing down 182 Bbls Lat 08 27 Lon 87 15 W

Tuesday Nov 23rd
This day begins with pleasant trades Bark on the port tack two sails in sight sent down main top sail and Reppart and bent it again at Sundown Bark on the starboard tack middle parts the same at day light and latter parts pleasant breeze two sails in sight Lat 08 15 Lon 86 42 W

Wednesday 24th
This day begins with pleasant breeze sprack Bark's Matilda Seard & Sea Fox at Sundown pleasant breeze continued middle parts strong wind at day light and latter parts the same Lat 08 10 Lon 85 30 W

Thursday 25th
This day begins with strong trades two sails in sight sprack Matilda Seard at Sundown strong wind continued middle and latter parts the same Lat 07 53 Lon 85 40 W

Friday 26th
This day begins with strong trades one sail in sight at Sundown took in sails on the starboard tack middle parts the same at day light and latter parts the same Lat 07 41 Lon 85 09 W

Saturday 27th
This day begins with strong trades on the port tack at Sundown on the starboard tack middle parts the same at day light and latter parts Bark on the port tack two sails in sight Lat 08 45 Lon 85 10 W

Sunday 28th
This day begins with pleasant trades Bark on the port tack took the Bark Sea Fox at Sundown two sails in sight middle parts the same middle parts at day light and latter parts pleasant weather

Monday 29th
This day begins with pleasant weather saw Matilda Seard & Sea Fox at Sundown fine weather at day light and latter parts the same two sails in sight Lat 08 50 Lon 84 49 W
