

Journal of Bark Mary Susan 1881

Sunday March 13th

This day begins with strong winds from S. Bark on the port tack at Sun down on the Starboard tack middle part strong wind Bark on the port tack at day light and latter part on the Starboard tack Lat 34.19 S Lon 75.24 W

Monday 14th

This day begins with strong winds from S. Bark on the Starboard tack at Sun down the same Continued middle part the same at day light and latter part strong winds Continued Bark on the port tack Lat 34.28 S Lon 75.25

Tuesday 15th

This day begins with strong winds from S. S. Bark on the port tack at Sun down the same middle part more moderate at day light and latter part moderate winds from S. S. W Lat 34.57 S Lon 74.82

Wednesday 16th

This day begins with moderate winds from S. S. W Bark on the Starboard tack one sail in sight at Sun down light winds from S. S. W steering S. E. middle part Calm at day light and latter part the same Lat 35.27 S Lon 74.00 W

Thursday 17th

This day begins with light air from S. W steering S. E. 1/2 S at Sun down moderate winds from S. S. W on the Starboard tack middle part the same at day light and latter part light winds from S. W steering S. E. by S land in sight

Friday 18th

This day begins with light wind from S. W steering S. E. by S at 5 p. M. passed the Island of Harker middle part Calm Bark in Salcahuano Bay at day light and latter part light air

Saturday March 19th

This day begins with light air at 7 P. M. Calm at day light and latter part fine weather at day light Calm tack anchor and move Ship latter part employed in the Ships duties

Sunday 20th

This day begins with Calm at Sun down the same middle part the same at day light and latter part fine weather

Monday 21st

This day begins with light winds and fine weather at Sun down the same middle part the same day light and latter part fine weather

Tuesday 22nd

This day begins with pleasant breeze at Sun down fine weather middle part the same at day light and latter part the same took on board one can of oil from Linda Steward and another from Matilda Seard

Wednesday 23rd

This day begins with fine weather employed in stowing oil at Sun down pleasant weather Continued middle part the same at day light and latter part the same employed in stowing oil

Thursday 24th

This day begins with fine weather employed in Ships duties at Sun down fine weather middle part the same at day light and latter part employed in the Ships duties took on board can of oil

Friday 25th

This day begins with moderate winds and fine weather at Sun down the same middle part the same at day light and latter part fine weather employed in the Ships duties
