Wednesday 8th
This day begins with strong winds from S.W.
steering N by E at sun down the same
continued middle part pleasant winds and
fine weather at day light and latter part the
same employed in making gib boom
Lat 33.10 S Lon 31.58 W

Thursday 9th
This day begins with pleasant breeze from
S.W. steering N by E one sail in sight
at sun down fine weather continued
middle part the same at day light and latter part
fine weather employed in making gib boom
one sail Lat 31.16 S Lon 31.29 W

Friday 10th
This day begins with moderate winds from S.W.
steering N by E at sun down pleasant winds
continued middle part pleasant breeze at day
light and latter part the same employed in
making gib boom Lat 29.07 S Lon 31.30 W

Saturday 11th
This day begins with pleasant breeze from S
steering N by E at sun down the same
continued middle and latter part breeze
one sail in sight Lat 26.36 S Lon 30.41 W

Sunday 12th
This day begins with pleasant breeze from S.S.E.
steering N by E at sun down one
sail in sight at sun down pleasant
breeze continued middle part light winds
at day light and latter part the same Lat 25.47 S Lon 30.22 W

Monday 13th
This day begins with light air and calm one
sail in sight at sun down the same middle
and latter part the same James Jackson left the
galley and not back any more Lat 24.50 S

Tuesday June 14th
This day begins with light air from N at sun
the part tack at sun down strong winds
from N middle part winds from N by W at day
light the same at ten A.M. wind hauled from
S.W. steering N by E Lat 23.37 S Lon 29.09 W

Wednesday 15th
This day begins with strong winds from S.W.
steering N by E at sun down the same
middle part strong winds at day light latter
part the same at ten A.M. Red Bank Island of
Bermuda bearing N Lat 20.40 S Lon 29.09 W

Thursday 16th
This day begins with strong winds from S.W.
steering N by E at two P.M. passed within 3 miles
of Bermuda Island at sun down strong
winds continued middle part strong trades
at day light and latter part the same Lat 17.65 S Lon 29.47 W

Friday 17th
This day begins with strong trades steering N
at sun down the same continued middle
and latter part strong squally trades steering
N passed a sail Lat 14.17 S Lon 31.12 W

Saturday 18th
This day begins with strong trades steering N by E
at sun down strong winds continued
middle part the same at day light and
latter part strong trades from E steering
N by E Lat 11.07 S Lon 32.28 W

Sunday 19th
This day begins with strong trades from E
steering N by E at sun down strong
winds continued middle part moderate
at day light and latter part calm and raining
weather Lat 09.50 S Lon 32.37 W
