Friday July 15th  
This day begins with moderate trade steering  
by the wind sail in sight at sun down  
the same continued middle and latter  
part

Lat 27.34 N Lon 64.43 W

Saturday 16th  
This day begins with light air and calm  
steering by the wind one sail in sight  
at sun down the same continued  
middle part calm at day light and latter part light  
winds from S.W. Six sails in sight

Lat 27.55 N  
Lon 65.17 W

Sunday 17th  
This day begins with light breeze from S.W. steering  
by the wind six sails in sight at sun down  
pleasant breeze continued middle part  
strong breeze at day light and latter part the same  
set up fore top mast back stays

Lat 29.40 N  
Lon 66.45 W

Monday 18th  
This day begins with strong winds from N.W. bark  
on the port tack at sun down bark under  
double reefed top sails middle part strong  
winds at day light and latter part the same

Lat 31.19 N no Lon

This day begins with strong winds from S.W.  
steering by the wind at three B.W. wind hauled  
from N.W. Rainy and squally weather  
at sun down moderate bark on the  
port tack middle part equally weather at day light  
and latter part calm

Lat 31.59 N Lon 67.47 W

Wednesday 20th  
This day begins with calm two sails in sight at  
sun down light air from N.W. middle part  
light winds from N bark on the starboard  
tack at day light and latter part calm

Lat 32.36 N Lon 67.35 W

Thursday July 21st  
This day begins with calm employed in  
the ships duties at sun down seven sails  
in sight calm continued middle  
part calm at 4 A.M. breeze from S.W.  
steering by the wind six sails in sight

Lat 33.21 N  
Lon 68.59 W

Friday 22d  
This day begins with strong winds from S.W.  
steering by the wind at sun down steering  
by the wind middle part heavy thunder storm  
bark on the under cloud reefed main topsail  
at four A.M. more moderate made sails  
with strong winds from N.W. steering by the wind  
one sail in sight

Lat 35.10 N  
Lon 69.56 W

Saturday 23d  
This day begins with moderate winds and squally  
weather one sail in sight at sun down light  
winds from S.W. middle part light and variable  
winds with thunder and lightning at day light  
got esquall call all hands and took in sails  
latter part strong winds from N.W. bark on  
the starboard tack one sail in sight

Lat 36.99 N  
Lon 70.34 W

Sunday 24th  
This day begins with strong winds from  
N.W. bark on the starboard tack one  
sail in sight at sun down make moderate  
wind from N middle part the same at  
day light and latter part light air & calm

Lat 36.41 Lon 71.40 W

Monday 25th  
This day begins with light air and calm at  
sun down light winds from S.W. steering  
by the wind 8 sails in sight middle part light  
air and calm at day light and latter part  
the same eight sails in sight

Lat 37.14 N
