

Bark Mary & Susan's Journal 1881

Tuesday July 26th

This day begins with light airs and calm & sails in sight at 4 p.m. light breeze from S. steering N by W at sun down the same middle part moderate wind from S.W. steering N by W at daylight the same five sails in sight at ten A.M. exchanged Longitude with the steamer Towerton bound to New York Lat 38 48 N Long 72 15 W

Wednesday 27th

This day begins with pleasant winds from S.W. steering N by E at sun down steering N by E by E middle part moderate winds at daylight and latter part the same Lat 41 36 N Long 71 30 W

Thursday 28th

This day begins with light winds from S.W. steering N by E by E at sun down sails middle part light airs and calm with thick weather at 12 M. heard the Breaks at 20 fms. cleared up Range at Bonough point at daylight calm latter part light winds from S.W. steering N by E

Friday 29th

This day begins with light winds from S steering N by E at one p.m. Range block Iceland at 4 p.m. took pilot at sun down light winds from S.W. steering N by E middle part light winds from S.E. at daylight thick fog over the bar and pig light Boat whistle to S
