

Remarks On board B^{re} ship Susan C. Ferguson 1887
Friday Jan 7th

Commences with a calm middle part a light breeze from E.S.E. B^{re} heading S. latter part the same hands employed in the rigging shooks B^{re} Europa clean so ends

Latt by Obs 42° 20' Lon 113° 18'

Saturday 8th

Commences with a fine breeze from E.S.E. B^{re} heading N.E. middle part wind the same at 12 A.M. lashed ship heading S. at 12 M. lashed again heading to the N.E. latter part wind the same B^{re} heading the same hands employed in the rigging so ends

Latt by Obs 54° 5' Lon 113° 26'

Sunday 9th

Commences with a fine breeze from S.E. B^{re} heading E.N.E. middle and latter part wind the same B^{re} steering from S.W. to N.W. commencing so ends at dark how to heading N.E.

Latt by Obs 50° 5' Lon 113° 34'

Monday 10th

Commences with a fine breeze from S.E. B^{re} heading E.N.E. at 1 A.M. was ship heading to the S.W. middle and latter part wind the same B^{re} steering from S.W. to N.W. by 8 A.M. at dark how to heading to the N.E. hands employed in the rigging so ends

Latt by Obs 45° 5' Lon 114° 16'

Tuesday 11th

Commences with a fine breeze from S.E. B^{re} heading E.N.E. middle and latter part wind the same B^{re} steering from S.W. to N.W. at dark how to heading to the N.E. hands employed in the rigging so ends

Latt by Obs 42° 20' Lon 115° 00'

Remarks On board B^{re} ship Susan C. Ferguson 1887
Wednesday Jan 22nd

Commences with a fine breeze from E.S.E. B^{re} heading N.E. middle and latter part wind the same B^{re} steering various courses with the Island in sight at dark the Island bore S.W. by W. distance about 15 miles saw three other ships the hands employed in ship duty so ends

Thursday 23rd

Commences with a fine breeze from E.N.E. B^{re} heading S.E. middle and latter part wind variable from E to N.E. B^{re} heading on different tacks missing at dark Island bore N.W. distance about 25 miles so ends

Friday 24th

Commences with a fine breeze from E.N.E. B^{re} heading S.E. middle and latter part a strong breeze from E.N.E. B^{re} heading N at dark was ship heading to the S.E. Island W. distance about 15 miles hands employed in setting up Fore & Main Top Mast Back stays and breaking out Water so ends

Saturday 25th

Commences with a strong breeze from E.N.E. B^{re} heading S.E. middle and latter part wind the same at 10.20 A.M. was a large whale going quick to windward towards the boats at 4 P.M. the boats returned when we were the whale the S.E. end of the Island bore S.W. by E distance about 5 miles saw another whale about 10 miles off shore at the same time and going the same way so ends
