

Remarks On board B^{ty} Mary & Susan Capt. Jennings 1847

Saturday Mar 5th

Commenced with a strong breeze from N^W B^{ty} heading E^{NE} middle part a calm latter part a light air from SE B^{ty} heading S^W N. carrying aboard Fishermans Point at dark bore E by N distance 20 miles hands employed in breaking out Water and Bunting, so ends

Sunday 6th

Commenced with a light breeze from N^W B^{ty} heading S^W middle and latter part a calm at dark Fishermans Point bore N^W distance 15 miles so ends

Monday 7th

Commenced with a fine breeze from N^W B^{ty} laying on different tacks aboard middle part a calm latter part a fine breeze from N^W B^{ty} having aboard heading off shore at dark Fishermans Point bore E by N, N^W distance 10 miles hands employed in shifting water in main hold so ends

Tuesday 8th

Commenced with a fine breeze from N^W B^{ty} carrying aboard heading E^{NE} middle part a C. latter part a fine breeze from N^W B^{ty} heading S^W hands employed in breaking out the mizzen tacks and between decks looking for Beans and cannot find them at dark the Island to the S distance Ten miles so ends

Wednesday 9th

Commenced with a fine breeze carrying aboard on opposite tacks middle and latter part on same hands employed in repairing mizzen top Mast Staysail and B^{ty} water so ends

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Saturday Mar 11th

Commenced with a strong breeze from N^W B^{ty} on different tacks middle part the same latter part wind the same at 10 AM a boat went on shore at 11 AM returned with 20 lbs also the crew that Capt. Owens would not arrive until the next day very pleasant to think of so ends

Sunday 10th

Commenced with a light breeze from N^W B^{ty} heading E^{SE} middle and latter part a calm having heading N^W distance 20 miles so ends

Monday 11th

Commenced with a light air from N^W B^{ty} heading E^{SE} middle part the same latter part a calm hands employed in shifting water so ends

Tuesday 12th

Commenced with a light air from N^W B^{ty} heading E^{SE} middle part a light breeze from N^W B^{ty} heading N^W at 9 AM saw sperm whales at 11 AM lowered a boat but never saw them they was going quick to the S^W saw a vessel to the N^W think she had been amongst them latter part a light air from N^W steering N^W by N bearing E^{NE} distance 20 miles

Wednesday 13th

Commenced with a calm middle part a fresh breeze from N^W B^{ty} heading on different tacks latter part a light breeze from N^W B^{ty} heading E^{NE} carrying aboard hands employed in shifting water the Island having from N^W distance 14 miles
