to Boatswain so ends put up gun at 5.30 P.M. No Obs

Commences with a strong breeze from N.W. steering N.W. middle
part a fresh breeze with heavy squalls from N.W. steering N.W.
latter part the same hands employed in ship's duty
so ends

part a light breeze with snow from N.W. steering N.W.
latter part a light breeze and clear from N.W. steering N.W.
hands employed in ship's duty so ends Lat by Obs 54.50 Lon 171.15

Thursday 25th

Commences with a fine breeze from S.E. steering N.W. middle
wind strong from S.E. with snow B^y steering the same at 11 A.M.
came up to scattering for S.W. 1 too heading to the S.W. at 1 P.M.
cleared up the fog off again and moved to S.W. and from that
to the N.W. with snow squalls latter part wind N.W. steering
N.W. hands employed in breaking out provisions so ends No Obs

Friday 26th

Commences with a fair breeze from N.W. steering N.W. middle part
a light breeze from N.W. with snow B^y heading N.W. latter part
the same hands employed in ship's duty so ends
Lat by Obs 56.57 Lon 171.53
