

Remarks On board B² Mary & Susan Capt. E. B. Fisher 1887
Saturday July 1st

Commenced with a light breeze from S. W. steering N. W. at 11.30 A.M.
passed East Cape Middle and latter part the same B²
steering N. hands employed in ship's duty so ends

Sunday 10th

Commenced with a strong breeze with fog from S. W. at 6 A.M.
hove to at 1 P.M. kept off a rain middle part 4 miles
the same and clear steering the same at 4.30 P.M. was Point
Hops and found 15 fathoms at anchor latter part a light air
from E. S. B² working up under the Pent so ends

Monday 11th

Commenced with a strong breeze from E. S. with fog B² lying at
Anchor middle and latter part wind from E. with heavy
rain so ends

Tuesday 12th

Commenced with a strong breeze from E. S. B² at anchor at 6 A.M.
took our anchor and steamed to the middle part a fair
at 3 P.M. came by anchor in 6 fathoms of water with
both anchors ahead abreast of the coal bins latter part
still blowing so ends

Wednesday 13th

Commenced with a fair from E. S. B² at anchor middle
part and latter a calm with fog hands employed in
blowing water in after hold and getting coal so ends

Thursday July 14th

Commenced with a calm B² at anchor middle and latter
part the same Capt. Owens came on board to deliver
his log hands employed in getting coal so ends

Friday 15th

Commenced with a calm B² still at anchor middle and
latter part the same received 10 boxes potatoes and one
box of butter from Tom Tye hands employed in getting coal
and breaking out water so ends let the Tom Tye have 2 Coats 37th 266

Saturday 16th

Commenced with a calm B² at anchor middle part light air &
variable at 1 A.M. took our anchor latter part a light breeze
from N. B² steering N. by E hands employed in ship's duty
so ends

Sunday 17th

Commenced with a light air from N. B² steering N. by E middle
part a light air from S. B² working to the latter part
a fine breeze from E. S. B² heading S. W. so ends

Monday 18th

Commenced with a strong breeze from E. S. B² working to the
middle part blowing fresh from E. S. B² working the same
latter part a fair at 4.45 P.M. anchored in 5 fathoms water
under the Lea & Point Hope so ends Rain

Tuesday 19th

Commenced with a fair with rain from E. S. B² lying at anchor middle
part the same shifted at 10 A.M. to day at 5 P.M. took our anchor and
kept off N. by E. hands employed in ship's duty so ends
